MIN 1/20/05/2021: PRELIMINARIES

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MIN 3/20/05/2021: BURSARY PROGRESS STATUS

The Bursary Committee Chair Mr. Hussein Konse informed the committee that the following Bursaries have been issued to the students as requested by the NGCDFC and the Bursary Team. The Committee agreed to issue the bursary funds as follows:

- Universities Kshs 8.2 Million; Kshs 4.5 Million to Colleges and Kshs 3.5 Million to Down Country Secondary Schools. See Attached Lists for Awards and issuance of cheques
- Further he suggested that Kshs 5,000,000 is ready for allocation to Secondary and College Applications from Sololo Sub County. The Committee approves this award after verification of the lists before them. See Attached Lists (parts of the funds).

The Chair also informed the committee that the Cheques for the Bursaries are ready and that the list of the successful applicants shall be pinned on the NG-CDF Notice Board.

MIN 4/20/05/2021: PROJECT STATUS FOR FY 2020-21

The Fund Manager gave a brief status of the projects for the FY 2020-21 to the committees who wanted to know whether procurement processes have been finalized. The Manager told the committees that all the PMCs for the projects are in place and the communication to start the procurement processes have been made to the PMCs.

MIN 5/20/05/2021: CAPACITY BUILDING FOR NGCDFC/MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF PROJECTS

The NG-CDFC requested the Fund Manager to organize a Capacity Building Workshop or a Benchmarking Exercise for the NGCDF.

A Committee Member, Mr. Mahad Mohamed suggested that the Constituency should make a visit to Nyali Constituency where some excellent projects have been undertaken and displayed in social media. Mr. Mahad told the members that it is good for the committees to visit such constituency where excellent projects have been carried out.

Another Committee Member, Mrs. Khadija also requested that committee be taken for training to in places like Mombasa, Nakuru and Embu to enhance its capacity to effectively perform its roles. The Members gave their suggestions and it was agreed that the Capacity Building be Conducted in the new future.

The Manager advised the committee that the office is waiting for communication from the regional coordinators for a joint training for upper eastern constituencies. As a tradition the Manager stated that constituencies join efforts to conduct regional workshop for the NGCDFC and hence he advised the committee to hold on for a while as the preparation is finalized.

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MIN 6/20/05/2021: RE-ALLOCATION OF PROJECTS AND CHANGE OF ACTIVITIES

The NGCDFC Deliberated on the proposal that the Kukub Primary School fencing works has been undertaken by the County Government of Marsabit and that the funds initially allocated for the project of Kshs 1,750,000 needs to be re-allocated to other projects.

The Committee noted that among the proposals received is the case of Anona Primary School which requires fencing to ensure the safety of the environment and Boarding Learners in the School. It was resolved that the project be re-allocated as hereunder:

Further the Committee deliberated on the Change of the Activities for the Upcoming St Marys' Secondary School in Moyale Town. The Committee decided that the project be implemented in two phases as follows: Where Phase one will involve the Foundation works for the three one storey classrooms, Slabbing, Superstructure walling to Shuttering works and phase two cover the superstructure first floor walling, roofing works, plastering and painting to finishing works.

The Committee requested the works officer to come up with the technical drawings and the Bill of Quantities for the works which is as attached. It was noted that the First phase of the works will cost Kshs 6,250,000 and the remaining phase Kshs 3,750,000.00. The Fund Manager was requested to apply for the change of activities as follows:
