## MINUTE 5/26/04/21/NG- CDFC/KASARANI: EMERGENCY REQUEST

The Fund Account Manager tabled two letters, one from the Sub County Director of Education and the other from Njiru Deputy County Commissioners office requesting for funds for fencing Njiru

secondary school. The Sub County Director's letter states that they are in the process of registering the school but the school compound requires immediate fencing as it is very exposed.

The letter from the DCC also states that the operation to remove illegal structures from the school land and its environment was complete and successful. However, the school land needs to be fenced immediately to avoid recurrence of encroachment. He also advised that due to security concerns and also lack of an existing PMC for the said project, the PMC for Njiru DCC's office should implement the project.

After lengthy discussion, the committee approved Kshs. 500,000 from emergency kitty to immediately fence the said school, by use of concrete posts. The said project shall be implemented by Njiru DCC's Project Management Committee.

The committee therefore approved implementation of the above projects except for Highway Manyatta Primary School which was not approved by the Board.

## MINUTE 7/26/04/21/NG- CDFC/KASARANI CHANGE OF PROJECT ACTIVITY

### Ngundu Primary School

The school had been allocated Kshs. 1,000,000 for four classrooms renovation, flooring and painting in FY 019/020. However, after a visit to the school it was noted that the said classes are in deplorable state and are not up to standard. The office of the Public Works advised that new classes should be constructed instead of face lifting the non-standard classrooms. The school management also resolved to change the activity from classroom renovation to purchase and installation of high

capacity pump of a rating of 1.5kw at a cost of Kshs. 600,000 and kshs. 400,0000 for renovation of 10 doors ablution block (Walls repair, painting, roofing, flooring).

#### Ruai Girls Secondary School

The school had been allocated Kshs. 1,300,000 for construction of 2no. Classrooms on 1<sup>st</sup> floor (walling and roofing) in FY 2019/2020. The two classes on the ground floor were constructed by the NG-CDF. However, after the review of the tests report conducted by the ministry of Public Works, it was noted that some recommended remedies have never been undertaken thus its unsafe to construct the first floor building. The school management committee thereafter met and resolved to change the activity to construction of one classroom.

The NG-CDFC unanimously approved change of activities in the two schools and requested the Fund Account Manger to communicate the same to the NG-CDF Board.
