The meeting was appreciative that the NG-CDF-Board had released all the funds for the FY 2021/2022 plus unremitted balance for the FY 2020/2021. The meeting further noted with gratitude that the constituency has not had any incident that is of emergency by nature. The meeting was also alive to the fact that the cost of living had skyrocketed further complicating the social economic effects of Covid 19. The issue was discussed at length and considered Bursary as the most important scheme because it targets the poorest segment of the society. If the request is granted the reallocated Bursary amount will go a long way to cushion the effects of the rising cost of living and ensure that needy students are kept in school. Therefore, the members unanimously agreed to seek for authority from the Board to reallocate the emergency funds amounting to Kshs. 7,192,207 and Kshs. 5,000,000 for Mathira Youth Empowerment Centre- purchasing studio equipment which is yet to start to the following projects as tabulated below.
