

MIN/NGCDF/CHANGAMWE 10/10/2024: RESUBMISSION OF FUNDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT IN JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL

As per the directive by principal secretary, State department for Basic education on infrastructure development for junior secondary schools vide reference number MOE.HQS/3/7/27(110).

The national treasury had allocated the ministry of education funds for construction of classrooms and integrated learning resource centres for junior secondary school. This amount was proposed to be jointly managed by the ministry of education and the national government constituency development fund. Changamwe constituency had been allocated Kshs. 6,984,133. After the Board's visit for project verification the committee recommended that we implement storey building structures. After receiving the projects estimates from public works for science and home science laboratories at Umoja Primary School, members deliberated and approved the new project as follows,

MIN/NGCDF/CHANGAMWE 11/10/2024: REALLOCATION OF UNSPENT EMERGECNY 2023-24

The Chairman informed members of the unspent emergency for financial year 2023-2024 of Kshs. 1,229,569 which has been received from the Board. FAM informed members of the issues of Ahmed Shahame Mwidani TTI project of construction of twin workshops. The project was allocated Kshs. 11,000,000. The work was awarded at Kshs. 10,800,900. There were some extra works which were done as instructed by Works officer totalling to Kshs. 1,000,000. The project is at 90% status but the contractor has stopped works until the issue is resolved. Members deliberated and agreed to reallocate the unspent emergency funds as follows,

MIN/NGCDF/CHANGAMWE 12/10/2024: REALLOCATION OF BOMU POLICE POST FUNDS

FAM informed members about the relocation of Bomu police post funds. The funds totalling Kshs. 6,000,000 were allocated in the financial years 2020-2021 for construction of a police post. The projects had failed to start since the land earmarked for the project was reported to be unfit to construct the police post since it was surrounded by residential houses and was also very small due to encroachment. The local administration has failed to find an alternative venue. Members had in the previous minutes' number MIN/NGCDF/CHANGAMWE 6/07/2024 agreed to reallocate it to St. Charles Lwanga secondary for laboratory but the amount was not enough for the estimated works. Members deliberated and agreed to reallocate to Chaani Primary School for construction of laboratory as summarized below.
