### MIN 1/NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: PRELIMINARIES

The chair called the meeting to order at 10.00am and requested Mr Mohamed Rahesi to offer a word of prayer. The Chairman welcomed all members and thanked them for being punctual.

### MIN 2/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The chair invited the secretary to take members through the agenda as was circulated. Members after deliberation adopted the agenda with without amendments as was proposed by Mr Edward Sakwa and seconded by Jane Makau.

### MIN 3/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The Secretary took the members through the Minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were confirmed to be the true copy of the previous meeting by Mohamed Rahesi and seconded by Jane Makau.

### MIN 4/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising from the previous Minutes.

### MIN 5/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The Fund manager brought to the attention of members the provisions of the Board's circular Ref No: NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 on the preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for 2024/2025 financial year. He informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of **Kshs. 179,441,954.47** and the committee is required to go by the guidelines given by the board in identifying and submission of the project proposals.

#### **a. Deliberation on the Ward Report**

The Chair tabled to members the ward report that was conducted between 11 and 13th November 2024 and it was agreed that this year the NGCDFC will not conduct any ward meeting and the members will rely on the ward meeting report held in November 2024 since it covers a period of two financial years that is financial year 23/24 and 24/25. From the report, the communities were guided on types of projects and the basis of consideration which included the amount allocated to the constituencies, constituency strategic plan and the National Government guiding policies. Each ward came up with at least 9 to 12 projects majorly in education, security and climate change areas as captured in the ward report (**annex 3**). Summary of the projects considered from the ward report per ward is as below;

### b. Ongoing Projects

The manager tabled a summary of the Monitoring reports that capture the status of all the projects and summary of the ongoing report that was submitted to the Board earlier. From the report there were no ongoing projects that will result in cost variations. All the previous projects were reported to be having adequate funds.

### c. Statutory ceilings for administration and Monitoring and Evaluation

The manager briefed members of the key guidelines by the Board and informed members that the Board laid more emphasis on the following areas;

- Provision of a detailed budget with clear breakdown of each component towards funds for administration and recurrent expenditure
- Allocation of funds to staff salaries to be informed by a documented staffing structure approved by the Committee with clear job description for each employee and must conform to the government guidelines on minimum wage.
- Consideration of other statutory deductions such as housing levy, National Social Security Fund (NSSF) and Social Health Insurance Fund (SHIF)

- Costing of the funds allocated to Monitoring and Evaluation to be informed by a proper work plan as provided in **annex 2**.

The said budgets were tabled by the manager and upon deliberations having considered the constituency allocation and the needs of the community, the committee members approved as provided in **annex 1**:

The committee agreed not to allocate the full amount for staff basic salary for the twelve months which was ksh 2,249,880 and instead allocated ksh 1,866,888 since there was unutilized balanced brought forward of ksh4,400,651 as at 1st July 2024.

#### **d. Climate change mitigation and adaptation activities**

The manager tabled a guideline on climate change issues by the Board. The committee after deliberation considered funding of tree planting in 4 schools that had requested for the same. The Fam informed the members that the four schools have submitted request letters for planting trees in their school and promised to nurture the trees to maturity. The names of the schools are indicated below

- 1) Shikaadabu primary school kshs 58,000
- 2) Mishimboko Primary School Kshs 58,000
- 3) Mishimboko Girls High School kshs 58,000
- 4) Timbwani Secondary School kshs 58,000

#### **e. Constituency Digital Hubs**

The Likoni NG-CDF has an existing and operational constituency Innovation Hub which is housed at Likoni NG-CDFC Offices.

#### **f. Funding of Social Security Programme and Social Support Programme**

The NG-CDFC committee members have resolved not to allocate any funds under social support programme this financial year due to uncertainty and lack of clarity with regard to registration of vulnerable persons.

#### **g. Proposed establishment of Security projects**

The committee has unanimously approved the construction of Shonda Police Station which has been long overdue. The project once completed will ensure improved security situation in a populous and rapidly growing area in Shikaadabu Ward. The project will mirror an existing police station at Shelly Beach Police Station.

The sub County Security Team has expressed huge satisfaction and thanked the area Mp for supporting the proposed construction of Shonda Police station.

#### **h. Final project proposed with list of all prioritized projects**

After a lengthy deliberation and consideration all areas as advised by the Board including but not limited to public participation, adequate consultation with public works, ongoing project, work plan and budgets for administration and monitoring vote, aligning project to BETA, constituency



strategic plan and other National Government Policies, the committee agreed on the below listed projects to be forwarded to the Board for consideration and approval.

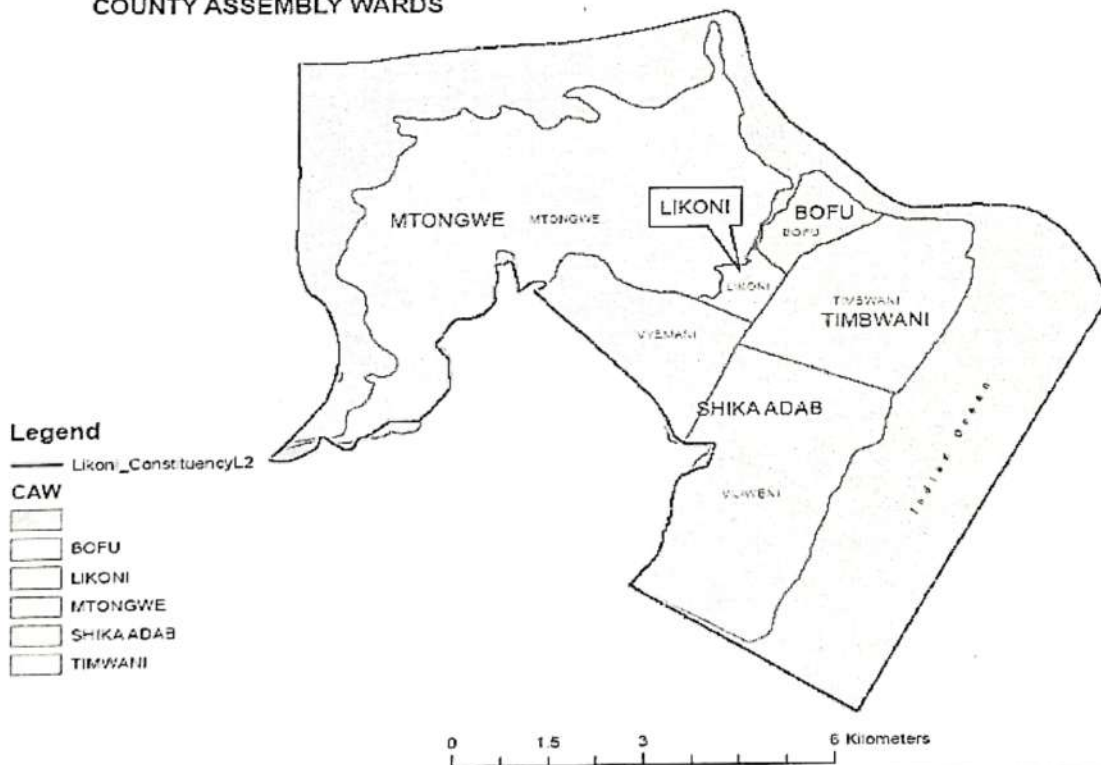

## 1.0 Background of Likoni Constituency

### NG-CDF Likoni Constituency

1. Likoni is one of the constituencies in Mombasa County. It is located in the South eastern part of the Coast Region and covers an area of approximately 105.9km square excluding 30km square of water mass. It borders Changamwe Constituency to the west, Mvita Constituency to the north, Indian Ocean to the east and Kwale County to the South and Western side.
2. The Constituency is divided into five (5) wards; Likoni, Timbwani, Bofu, Shikaadabu and Mtongwe.
3. The constituency is densely populated due to low cost of housing and secure environment.
4. The NG - CDF is a key driver of socio- economic development in the constituency. The fund focuses on projects that have immediate socio-economic impact with a view to improving lives, alleviate poverty and address general development.

## 2.0 About the National Constituency Development Fund (NGCDF)

The main source of funding at the constituency level remains the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NGCDF) which was established through enactment of the CDF Act, 2003 as repelled in 2015, and amended in 2016 as one of the devolved funds meant to achieve rapid socio-economic development at the constituency level through financing of locally prioritized projects and enhancing community participation.

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NGCDF) is established under the NGCDF Act 2015 (as amended in 2016). The primary objective is to address Poverty Alleviation by dedicating at least 2.5% of Annual Ordinary Government Revenue for development purposes at the grassroots level.

In accordance with the provisions of the NGCDF Act 2015, as amended in 2016, significant control and executive decision making has been devolved to the grassroots level. At the constituency level, the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee is the key stakeholder in facilitating development in their respective constituencies as they prioritize issues to be tackled and coordinate the implementation through engagement of relevant stakeholders such as the project management committees and respective government

departments and agencies. The participation approach has enhanced establishment of elaborate systems of checks and balances to curb misuse of resources and improved service delivery.

Since inception in 2003, as Constituency Development Fund (CDF), it has implemented high impact projects, which have revolutionized the development agenda in the country. NGCDF Likoni Constituency has been one of the most successful funds with high support rate from the locals. The constituency's main focus has been on infrastructural improvement being in education, security, environment, sports and social security programs.

Major sectors funded under the 2015 NGCDF Act as amended in 2016 includes education, bursary and social programs, security, sports and environment.

### 3.0 ACHIEVEMENTS

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund continues to be the most successful story of a devolved fund that is felt at the furthest corner of every marginalized community of our land.

3. The number of public primary schools is very low compared to private schools. Hence there is an urgent need to start additional schools in all the wards.
4. The constituency also lacks adequate boarding schools. We need a number of model boarding schools that can be used to boost performance.
5. Grabbing of land earmarked for development by private developers making it difficult to implement some projects.
6. Inadequate project implementation support from government technical offices

The ward meetings were conducted in five wards from 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> October 2023 all participants were allowed to attend.

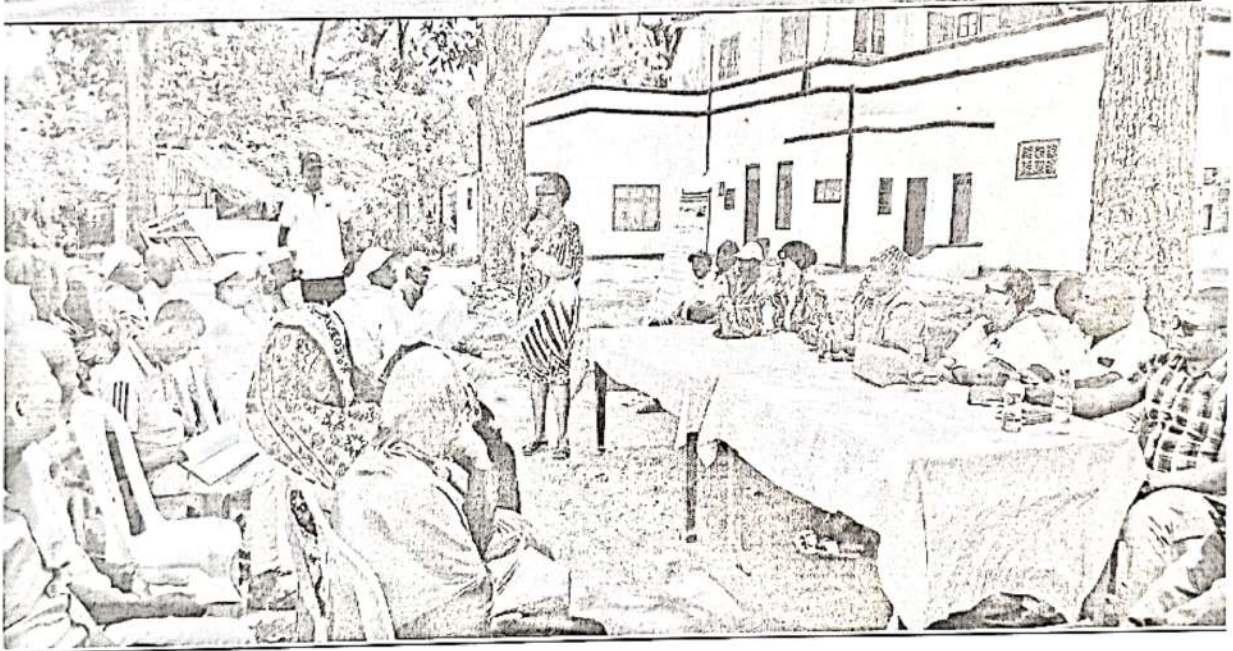

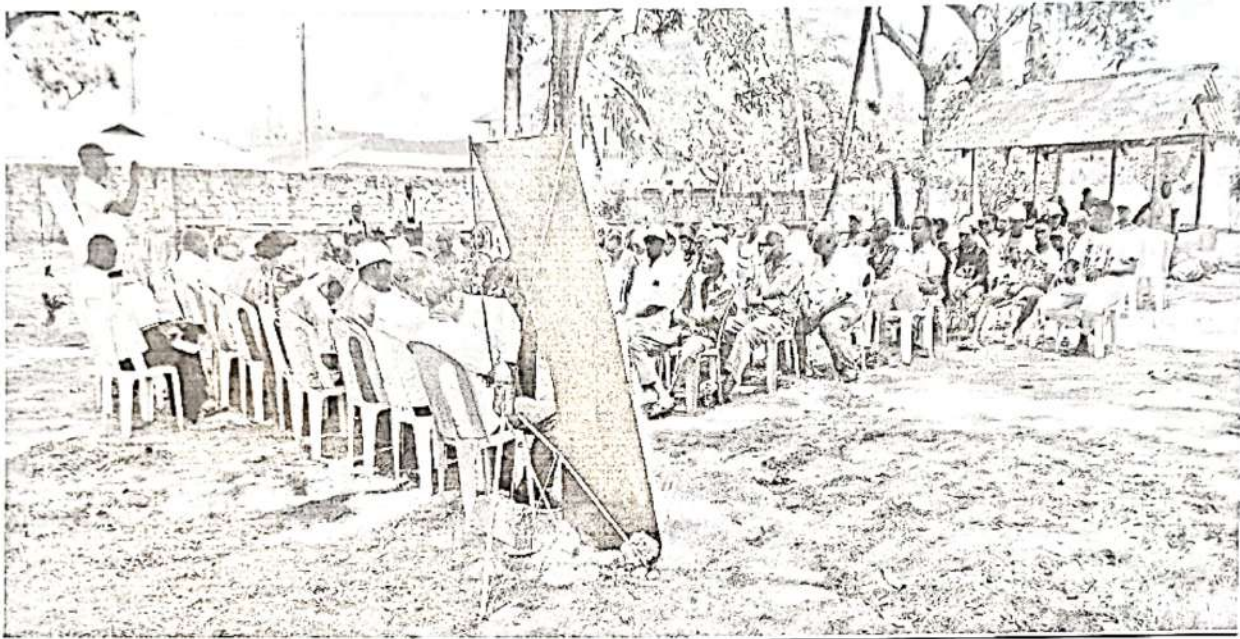
