MIN 5/ NG-CDFC/12/2024/2025: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The Fund manager brought to the attention of members the provisions of the Board's circular Ref No: NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22nd October 2024 on the preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for 2024/2025 financial year. He informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of Kshs. 170,474,856.74 for the current Financial Year

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Projects with pending issue

Members discussed the fate of five (5) projects which were approved, funded and funds transferred to Project Management Committee Accounts for implementation and contractors were paid their contract sum in full despite projects being incomplete. It was resolved that the contractors for the five (5) projects be held accountable and recalled to finish the projects pending works instead of allocating more funds to projects that were already budgeted for and money released for the same purpose. The NG-CDF Chairperson was tasked to follow up the matter to establish why contractors were paid and still abandoned site so that Lungalunga Constituents can get value for their money on the projects.

Climate change mitigation and adaptation

The fund account manager presented to the committee the aspect of planting trees and solar installation in learning institutions. The committee discussed the matter and resolved to supply and install solar power in learning institutions which have not benefitted from the run electrification program. Mr. Sabastian Jeremiah Kombeti proposed Mtudwini primary school to benefit from the program and was seconde by Mrs. Selina Santo.

The committee members discouraged the issue of planting trees due to the following challenges

- i. The trees previously planted in the learning institutions are not doing well because of much drought in the constituency
- ii. The Constituency is a low land area hence during rainy seasons the newly planted trees are swept away by floods leaving bare ground iii. The board has not clearly come up with a guideline that will support growing of trees in learning institutions hence most funds injected in this project does not give value to the community

d. Constituency Digital Hubs

Members agreed to start implementing the basic model digital hub due to budget constraints. After long deliberations on where the digital hub to will be constructed Mrs. Beatrice Mbindyo proposed Lungalunga town in Vanga ward because there is government fiber optic internet connectivity. Mr. Salim Boi seconded the opinion and all agreed that the first Digital hub be constructed at Lungalunga town.

e. Proposed establishment of Security projects

The Fund Account Manager tabled a letter from the Deputy County commissioner communicating the decision of the Sub County Security Council on establishment and construction of Mrima Assistant chief's office. Members discussed the request letter and thereafter agreed to allocate funds for the same to bring close service delivery to the community who used to trek long distance in search of services from the assistant chief. The fund account manager was tasked with the responsibility to confirm availability of public land for the construction of the said office.

f. Proposed purchase of school buses and vans

During public participation forums conducted in Dzombo ward the parents requested for purchase of school bus as a way of expanding the school and also creating income avenue. The members discussed this request and unanimously agreed to approve purchase of Hino bus. The fund account manager was tasked to confirm prices from the government motor vehicle contracting agreement so as to determine realistic project cost.

g. Junior Secondary School Projects

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The committee members discussed the ward forum reports to establish which projects to be implemented during FY 2024/2025. The community and learning institutions appreciated NG-CDF Lungalunga for considering funding of Junior secondary school projects in the previous financial year where eight (8) Junior secondary school laboratories were constructed.

Despite the need for more classrooms to accommodate grade 9 students in Junior secondary school, the schools requested NG-CDF Lungalunga to supply laboratory apparatus in FY 2024/2025 so that laboratories can be fully utilized. Considering this request, members unanimously agreed to equip the laboratories

The committee finally approved the below list for funding in the financial year 2024/2025 and tasked the manager to forward the same to the Board for approval.



1.0 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NGCDF) is under the Ministry of Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

1.1 BACKGROUND INFORMATION – LUNGALUNGA CONSTITUENCY

1.1.1 Introduction

Lungalunga is located in extreme southeastern Kenya, at the international border with Tanzania. This location lies approximately 102 kilometers (63 mi), by road, south of the port city of Mombasa, the nearest large city. The Constituency borders Msambweni Constituency along River Ramisi in the North, Tanzania in the South, Coastal strip (Indian Ocean) in the East and Kinango Constituency in the West. The Constituency lies at an altitude of approximately 4000ft. or 1330m above sea level. It covers an area of 2803.83Km2.

Lungalunga is a settlement and a Sub-County in Kwale County Kenya, and the seat of the Deputy County Commissioner in Lungalunga Town. It is one of four constituencies in Kwale County. The constituency has four wards; Pongwe Kikoneni, Dzombo, Mwereni and Vanga/Lungalunga, all of which are within Kwale County. The constituency was established in the year 2013 from the larger Msambweni following the devolution of the Kenyan government system. The current Lungalunga MP is Mangale M. Chiforomodo who is serving his first term since 8th September 2022.

1.1.2 Eligible Projects Fundable as per NG-CDF Act 2016

1.1.3 The ineligible projects include:

- Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities
- Project supporting political bodies or political activities
- · Recurrent costs of completed projects
- Personal awards
- Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others
- Projects addressing devolved functions as outlined in the fourth schedule of the constitution of Kenya

1.1.4 Establishment of Lungalunga NG-CDF Committee

The Lungalunga Constituency Development Fund Committee is established under the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act of 2015. The Committee is expected to play the following roles:

- Allocation of funds to various projects, determining the quantum of installments to various projects in the constituency, taking into account the disbursement received and the requirement of different projects;
- Submission of a list of constituency based projects to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board within the stipulated time;
- Determination of the allocation of the emergency reserve in accordance with the NG-CDF Act, 2015;
- Making appropriate consultations with the relevant Government departments to ensure that cost estimates for the projects are as realistic as possible; and
- Ranking the constituency projects in order of priority, among other activities.

1.1.5 Implementation of Projects in Lungalunga

As stipulated in NG-CDF Act 2015, the Lungalunga Chairperson of the NG-CDFC, has been convening open public forum in the four (4) wards of the constituency todeliberate on development matters in the ward and the constituency. Each Ward prepares a list of priority projects and submits to the NG-CDF for deliberations. All the NG-CDF projects are implemented by the project management committee with the assistance of the relevant department of Government officers.

1.2 RATIONALE FOR PUBLIC WARD FORUMS

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 as amended in 2022 provides that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency. The Committee shall deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency committee



considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow stakeholders that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the development programmes.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development programmes in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. The NG-CDF Committee through public participation identifies public concerns and values that will help them develop a broad consensus on sustainable programmes in the constituency. The Chairperson shall therefore ensure adequate consultation with local leaders and shall publicize public ward meetings so as to reach as many constituents as possible. The main purpose for the public forum is to:

- Sensitize the community on matters NG-CDF especially on the key mandate and functions adducible to the Fund
- Give the community opportunity to deliberate on development matters in the wards and in the constituency.

The expression and harmonization of the mentioned challenges informs key programmes to be considered for Funding through NG-CDF Programmes in the constituency. For clarity and confirmation of the same, NG-CDF Committee undertook public ward forums that was scheduled for 31th November 2024 to 7th December 2024. The exercise was carried out for 8 days covering all the four wards in the constituency namely Pongwe Kikoneni, Dzombo, Vanga and Mwereni



b) Preliminaries

The meeting began with a word of prayer, thereafter, Vanga location area chief welcomed members to the meeting and introduced the members of the ward development committee and Senior Chief. He handed over the programme to the NG-CDF office to highlight the day's agenda.

c) Comments by the Deputy County Commissioner

Decentralized funds are established to increase community participation in local decision making, enhance government transparency, speed up government responsiveness, and improve quality of service delivery.

f) Comments by the Area Member of National Assembly

He pointed out that the impact of NG-CDF cannot be underrated in transforming people's lives in the country. In the education sector, NG-CDF has facilitated construction of various

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infrastructural developments in schools, and this has assisted in increasing student enrolment and offering of conducive learning environment. The NG-CDF bursary has helped retain in schools students from low income families. Hence, the public should champion for the protection and retention of the fund as much as possible.



b) Preliminaries

c) Comments by the Area Chiefs

Further he also highlighted the ineligible projects which include: Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities, projects supporting political bodies or political activities, recurrent costs of a completed projects, personal projects, private projects and projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others.





f) Comments by the NG-CDFC Chairman

The chairman thanked the constituents for attending the meeting. He explained the relevance of the meeting and the need for NG-CDFC to convene open forum public meetings in every ward within the constituency to deliberate on development matters and project priorities in the ward and the constituency.

g) Comments by the Area Member of National Assembly

He reiterated on the need of equitable distribution of resources as opposed to equal distribution, to enable all the areas in the constituency get the requisite development initiatives for better livelihood and stressed on stewardship of funds by the community members since they are the development consumers and community watch dogs.

i) Challenges

Members expressed concern on the restrictive nature of the projects fundable by NG-CDF, especially in the agricultural, health and roads sectors, but the area member of national assembly urged them to forward the projects to the area member of county assembly who was also present in the meeting.

j) Way Forward

The meeting resolved that all the funds disbursed to projects be spent prudently and equitable to promote value for money and boost the livelihood of the residents.

CONCLUSION

- The meeting vested the area member of national assembly with the responsibility of appealing to the NG-CDF Board to release funds to the constituency in time within the financial year to help projects development and payment of school fees to bright but needy students.
- Frequent development forums should be held to give the public information concerning the development initiatives being undertaken by all the development partners and the various funding agencies.
- There should be a joint forum where NG-CDF. County Government and other development stakeholders plan together to avoid duplication of projects.
- The meetings resolved that ongoing project shall be given precedence, to fast track their utilization to enable the beneficiaries get value for money.
- Allocations to projects should also be adequate, to enable completion of project once started, since if completion is delayed the project cost rises due to factors like inflation and wear and tear.
