## Project proposal for 2018/2019 financial year

The Fund Manager informed members that the allocation table for 2018 was released on 30/10/2018 through circular Ref number NG-CDFB/CIRCULARS Vol II (008). The circular was tabled for all members to read and understand the content.

Members confirmed that ward development forums held in January 2018 resulted into a very comprehensive ward report as well as to the development of Kilifi North Constituency strategic plan which will be launched soon.

Fredrick Kutakasa requested the ward development report to be tabled for members to go through and consider projects that were not funded in the 2017/2018 proposal. He urged members to prioritise the nost urgent projects and also consider balancing projects from different wards to ensure equity. The Fund Manager advised members to strictly consider projects that fall within the National Government docket; Education and Security. Members agreed to focus on completing ongoing projects first before committing funds to new projects.
