#### 0.0 Introduction / Background

#### 0.1 About NG-CDF

National Government Constituencies Development Fund came into being through an Act of Parliament, the NG-CDF Act, 2015 as amended in 2022 with an aim of combating poverty and promoting equitable growth and development around the country. Kilifi South Constituency borders Rabai, Kilifi North, Kaloleni, Ganze and Kisauni Constituencies and also the Coastal strip.


The Constituency is currently represented in the National Assembly by a second and current MP; Hon. Kennedy Richard Kiti Chonga who was re-elected on his second term.
