Considering that the constituency funded 19 JSS schools for construction and equipping of classrooms amounting to Kshs.39,846,766 in the previous financial year and the constituency ongoing projects in need of more funding amounting to Kshs.89,125,112 , the committee resolved to consider factoring funds to complete the projects and consider the rest in the subsequent financial years.

During the discussion on the status of the ongoing projects in need of funding, the Sub-county Education officers in the two sub- counties concurred with the members to hold for some time and probably fund some of the projects with emergency fund when due .

MIN NO: NG-CDF/KILIFI SOUTH/07/27TH NOVEMBER, 2024: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The Fund manager brought to the attention of members the provisions of the Board's circular Ref. No: NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22nd October 2024 on the preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for 2024/2025 financial year. He informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of Kshs.179, 467,954.47 for the current Financial Year and that the following key guiding areas as per the circular shall guide the preparation and submission of the proposals to the Board for consideration:

1. Project identification through ward forums
2. Consultation with the appropriate agencies on realistic project cost estimates
3. Consideration of ongoing projects
4. Budgeting of administration and Monitoring expenses
5. Consideration of climate change mitigation and adaptation activities
6. Financing of Constituency Digital Hubs
7. Funding of social security programme and Social Support Programme
8. Aligning Projects to BETA, Constituency Strategic Plan and other National Policies

a. Deliberation on the Ward Report

The Chair tabled to members the ward report that was conducted between 4th November and 20th November, 2024. From the report, the communities were guided on types of projects and the basis of consideration which included the amount allocated to the constituencies, constituency strategic plan and the National Government guiding policies. Each ward came up with projects in education, security and climate change areas as captured in the ward report (annex 3). The members realized that it would not be possible to fund as many projects as they would have liked during the financial year due to massive financial commitment on ongoing projects. Summary of the projects considered from the ward report per ward is as below:

b. Realistic Project cost estimates

Members were informed that the Fund Account Manager had been in consultation with the Public Works Officer on preparation of Bills of Quantities for the renovation works at Katikirieni Primary School to be funded in 2024-2025 financial year proposal in order to ensure realistic costs of the project.

c. Ongoing Projects

The Fund Account Manager table a summary of the Monitoring reports that capture the status of all the projects and summary of the ongoing report that was submitted to the Board earlier. From the report, 4 projects were reported as ongoing. This was as a result of projects that were to be funded in different phases and required additional funds to either complete a phase or final phase. The manager reminded members that funding of ongoing projects takes precedence and must be done within three financial years. The members approved funding of the ongoing projects as listed in the table below:

d. Statutory ceilings for administration and Monitoring and Evaluation

The manager briefed members of the key guidelines by the Board and informed members that the Board laid more emphasis on the following areas:

- Provision of a detailed budget with clear breakdown of each component towards funds for administration and recurrent expenditure
- Allocation of funds to staff salaries to be informed by a documented staffing structure approved by the Committee with clear job description for each employee and must conform to the government guidelines on minimum wage.
- Consideration of other statutory deductions such as housing levy, National Social Security Fund (NSSF) and Social Health Insurance Fund (SHIF)
- Costing of the funds allocated to Monitoring and Evaluation to be informed by a proper work plan as provided in annex 2.

The said budgets were tabled by the manager and upon deliberations having considered the constituency allocation and the needs of the community, the committee members approved as provided in annex 1:

e. Climate change mitigation and adaptation activities

The Fund Account Manager tabled a guideline on climate change issues by the Board. Further, the Committee members were reminded of the rise in the Climate Change Mitigation Activities funds to a ceiling of 5% and running for 10 years in order to achieve the National Agenda on Climate Change Mitigation. The committee after deliberation decided not to fund any of the projects in this sector due to the commitment of the constituency on the ongoing projects.

f. Constituency Digital Hubs

The Fund Account Manager further stressed the need to adhere to the presidential directive that all constituencies to fund digital hubs in all sub-counties from the NGCDF funds. Most of the areas with electricity where the project could be implemented was in Mtwapa Town. The NGCDFC had earmarked land owned by the County Government which was still not yet approved for use by the NGCDF. Members decided not to fund the project in the current financial year until the formalities of land approval were concluded.

g. Social security programme and Social Support Programme

The Chairperson commented that in the last financial year, NGCDFC had allocated Kshs. 900,000 for the use of the elderly and the vulnerable group for NHIF. Due to the changes that came into being no single cent had been utilized to date as the systems of remittances was not clear. Members agreed to first utilize

the available funds first before allocating new funding thus no more funds were allocated in the current financial year.

h. Final project proposed with list of all prioritized projects

After a lengthy deliberation and consideration in all areas as advised by the Board, including but not limited to public participation, adequate consultation with public works department, ongoing projects report, work plan and budgets for administration and monitoring vote, aligning project to BETA, constituency strategic plan and other National Government Policies, the committee agreed on the projects to be forwarded to the Board for consideration and approval as listed in the following table.





1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 About NGCDF

National Government Constituency Development Fund previously known as Constituency Development Fund was initiated in 2003/04 financial year through the CDF ACT of 2003. The CDF Act 2003 was amended in 2007 and repealed in 2013 and again in 2015. The operations of the fund are currently guided by the NG - CDF Act of 2015. Section 4(1) of the NG - CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016 establishes the fund as a kitty consisting of monies of an amount not less than 2.5% of all National Government's share of revenue as divided by the Annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the constitution.

1.2 About Kilifi South NGCDF

Kilifi South Constituency is an electoral constituency within Kilifi County in Kenya. It is one of the new constituencies which emanated from the old Bahari Constituency after being split into two constituencies; Kilifi North and Kilifi South

The Constituency borders Rabai, Kaloleni, and Kilifi North, Ganze and Kisauni Constituencies and also the coastal strip. The Constituency is IEBC No. 012 of the 290 Constituencies in Kenya.

The Constituency is currently represented in the National Assembly by a second and current MP; Hon. Kennedy Richard Kiti Chonga who was re-elected on his second term.

Number of Wards

Kilifi South is divided into two divisions namely; Kikambala and Chonyi Divisions and has five County Assembly Wards namely:

1. Mwarakaya Ward
2. Chasimba ward
3. Junju Ward
4. Mtepeni Ward
5. Shimo La Tewa Ward

The Constituency has an estimated population of 171,607 according to the Kenya population Housing Census 2019, covering an area of approximately 400.60km².

The area is mainly inhabited by Chonyi but has a significant number of Kauma, Giriama and other Kenyan tribes who are either working or living in the area.

Economic activities

Kilifi South Constituency economy is dominated by small scale farming and peasantry activities. Being the staple food all Kilifi South residents plant maize for both food and cash.

Other economic activities include Tourism, farming (cashewnuts, coconuts, sisal, maize, mangoes, oranges etc.) and fishing. Large chunks of land in form of ranches has also scaled up the Constituency's potential in livestock production. There are also small scale trading enterprises which include shop keeping, buying and selling of cereals, vegetables and Matatu transport businesses.

Milestones

Kilifi South has a total of 78 public primary schools and 23 secondary schools. Kilifi South NGCDF has so far funded construction and rehabilitation of infrastructure in 61 primary schools and 19 secondary schools among other projects of different sectors.

1.3 Constituency Allocation

The constituency have been allocated a total of Kshs. 1,351,634,392 from financial year 2013/2014 to 2023/2024. The breakdown is as tabulated.

1.4 Kilifi South NGCDF performance

Kilifi South National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee (NGCDFC) pursuant to the provisions of the National Government CDF Act 2015, allocate funds to various projects with reference to the priorities of the public participation meetings held across the constituency.

The main purpose of the NGCDF is enhancing infrastructure and social –economic development at constituency level particularly in the areas of Education, security and environment.

Prior to the NGCDF (Amendment) Act 2016, Kilifi South NGCDF committee had through public participation identified various projects for funding in line with the Act and Regulations in place at the time (CDF Act 2013). The projects funded were spread out in various sectors including: Education, security, Bursary, Sports, Health, Environment, Roads, and Water.

The NGCDF Committee undertake to expedite disbursement of funds to earmarked projects in accordance with the provisions of the NGCDF Act of 2015 and the requirements of the Annual Performance Contract. Timely disbursements facilitate implementation of approved projects activities across the constituency.
