The code list for the following projects is yet to be received:

- i. Construction of one classrooms at Mwarakaya secondary school
- ii. Construction of one classrooms at Junju secondary school
- iii. Landscaping and fencing at Chonyi police station and
- iv. Purchase of office furniture and equipment

The NG – CDF Board is yet to respond to clarifications provided related to the conditions set when the projects were being approved late last year.

MIN NG-CDF/KILIFI SOUTH 5/22/10/19: Reallocation of funds

1. Purchase of land for construction of a new primary school at Mtwapa

Mtwapa is in Shimo la Tewa Ward which is a densely populated area and served by only two public primary schools namely; Mtomondoni primary school and Mtwapa primary school. Mtomondoni primary school has a very high student population of more than 2500 that makes it difficult for students to have a conducive environment. The high number is also putting pressure on existing facilities. The proposed school is intended to ease the pressure and reduce the distance covered by some students that come from far flung areas. The cost of the land is estimated at Kshs. 12,300,000

2. Purchase of Motor Bike for clerk of works. The project was allocated Kshs. 400,000 last financial year but the funds are inadequate for a YAMAHA DT 125 which is the recommended motor bike. At Toyota Kenya Limited the motor bike is retailing at Kshs. 511,415.00.

The committee discussed the two issues and resolved as follows:

- 1. Reallocate Kshs. 4,000,000 from the Chonyi Police Station
- 2. Reallocate Kshs. 111,415 from emergency funds

as follows:



- 1. Part payment for purchase of school land at Mtwapa Kshs. 4,000,000
- 2. Additional funding towards purchase of motor bike for clerk of works

The NG-CDFC perused through the ward report and after making various considerations such as school population and state of infrastructural facilities agreed on the following project proposal:




