#### 1. INTRODUCTION

National Government Constituency Development Fund previously known as Constituency Development Fund was initiated in 2003/04 financial year through the CDF ACT of 2003. The CDF Act 2003 was amended in 2007 and repealed in 2013 and again in 2015. The operations of the fund are currently guided by the NG - CDF Act of 2015. Section 4(1) of the NG - CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016 establishes the fund as a kitty consisting of monies of an amount not less than 2.5% of all National Government's share of revenue as divided by the Annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the constitution.

Section 27(1) of the Act as amended in 2016 requires that the chairperson of the constituency Committee shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meeting in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency

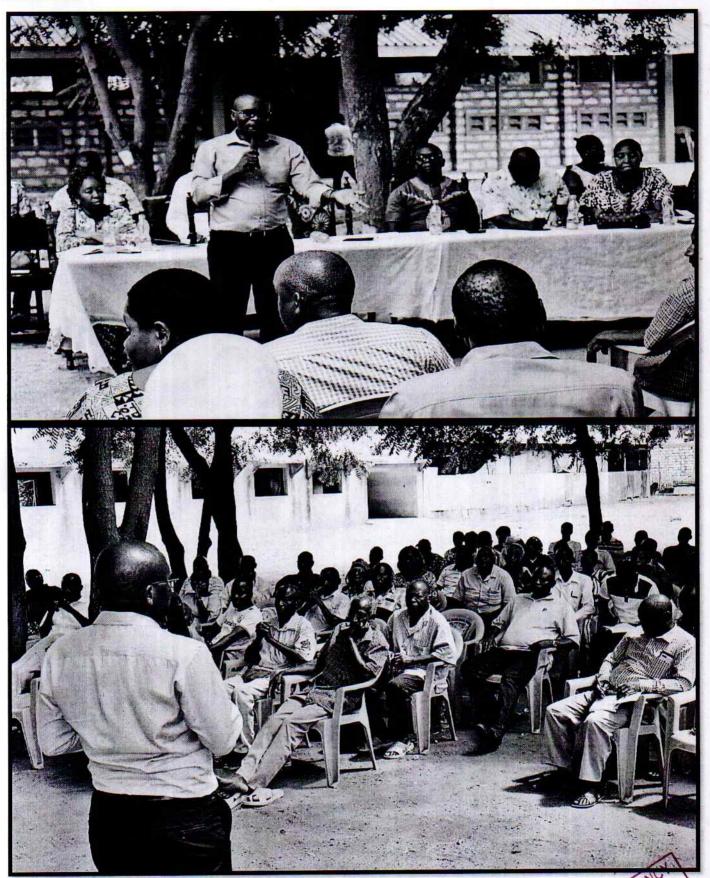


Table 1: Public Participation in Ganda Ward.

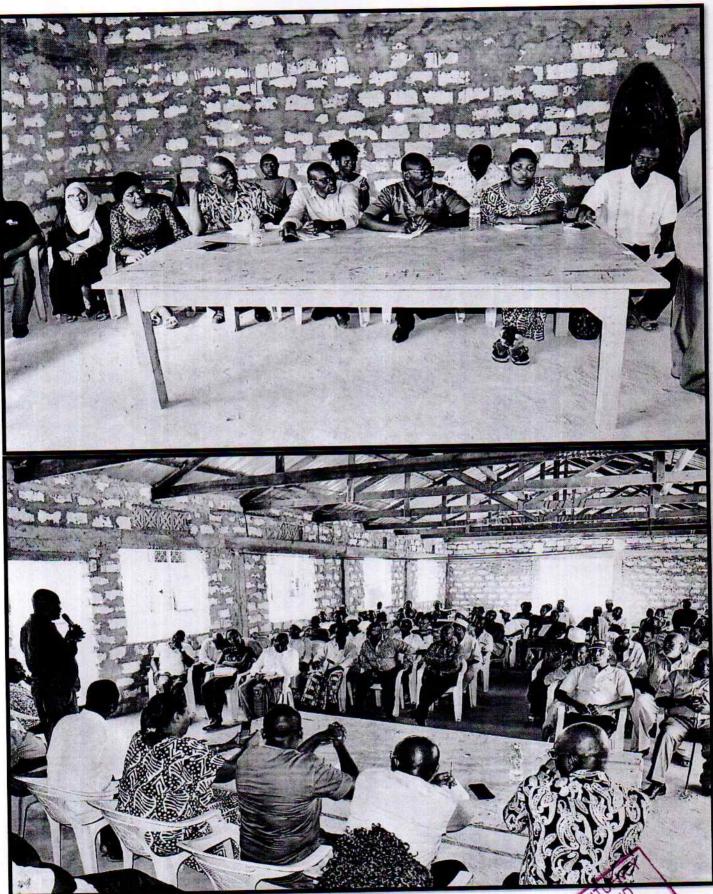


Table 2: Public Participation in Shella Ward



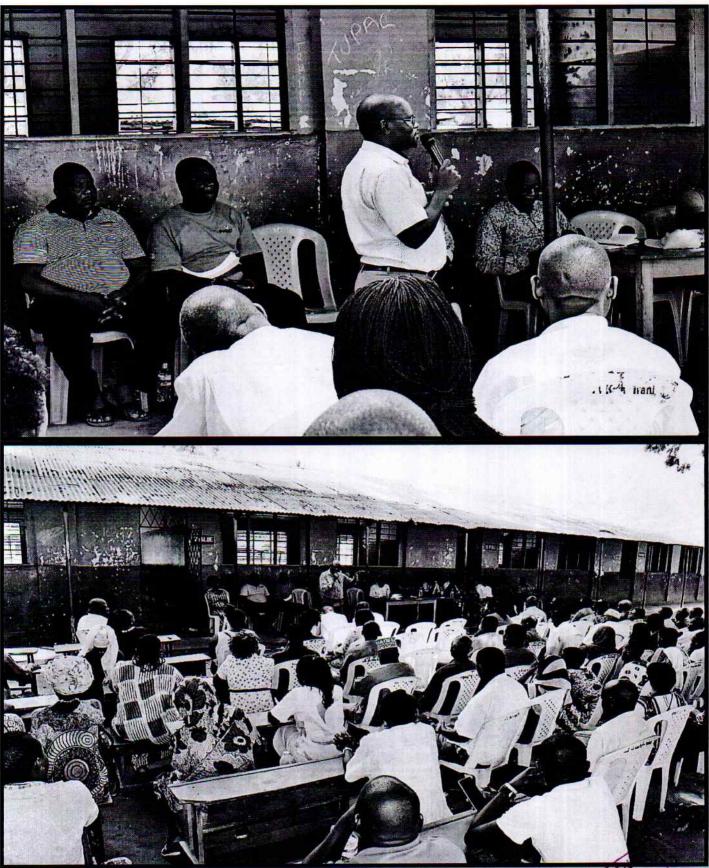


Table 3: Public Participation in Malindi Town Ward



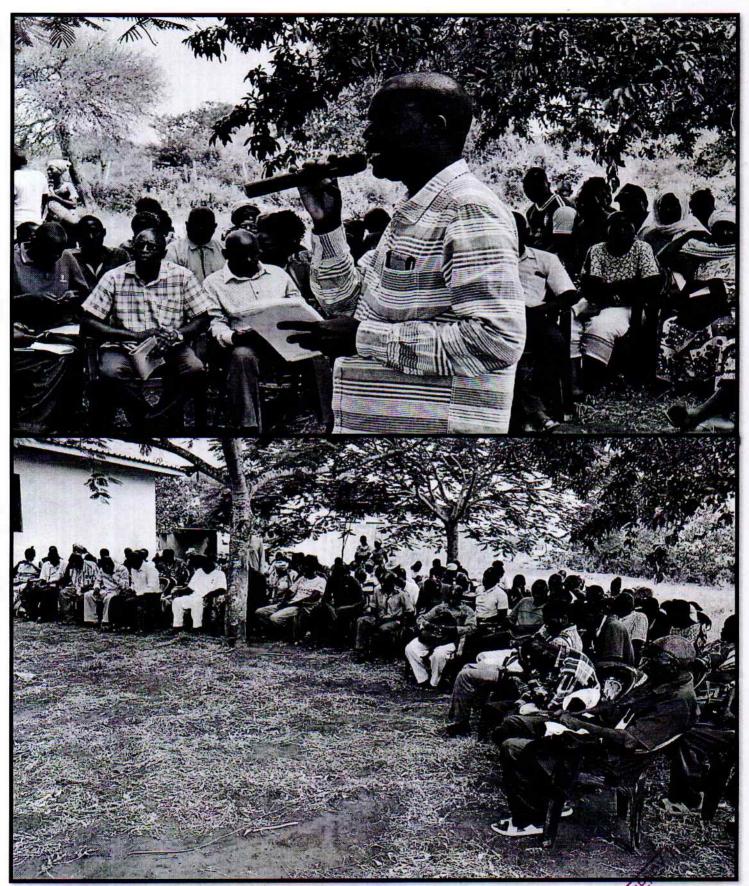


Table 4: Public Participation in Jilore Ward



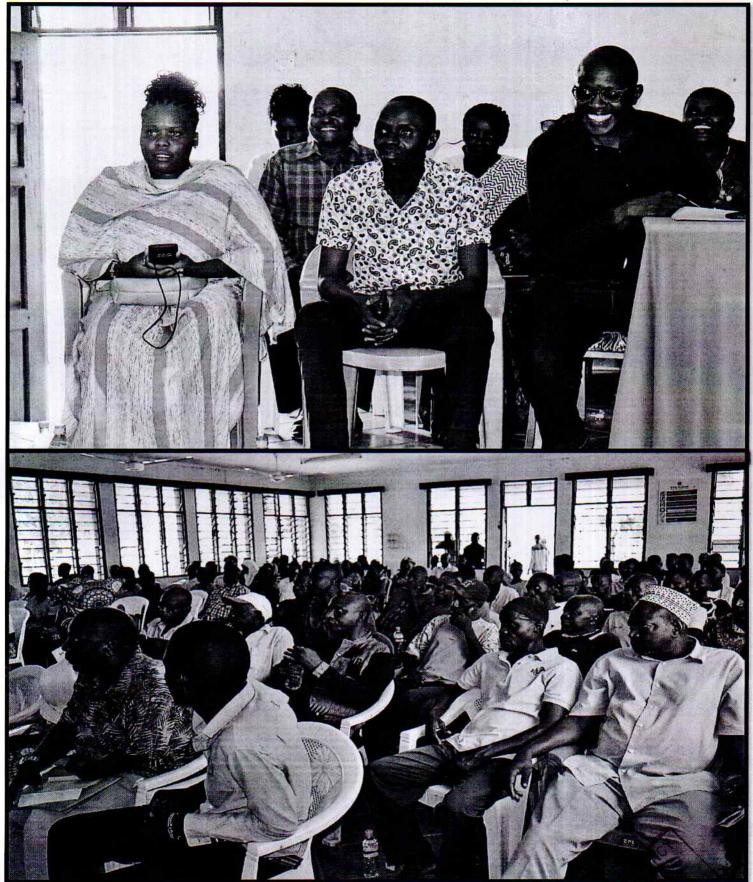


Table 5: Public Participation in Kakuyuni Ward

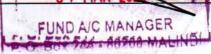
