INTRODUCTION OR BACKGROUND

0.1 About NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under the NG – CDF ACT of 2015 and its amendments 2022. The primary objective of the NG-CDF is to address Poverty alleviation by dedicating at least 2.5 % 0f annual ordinary Government revenue for development purposes at the grassroots level.

Magarini constituency is located in the north of Kilifi County in the coastal region of Kenya. It is one of the seven (7) constituencies in Kilifi County. It is constituency no. 017 and in a coverage area of approximately 6979.40 sq.km. It has two Sub counties; Magarini North and Magarini South.



b. Realistic Project cost estimates

All the allocation to the infrastructural projects were guided by the public works who was in attendance. To ensure realistic project costings, the officer mentioned the following key issues to be considered by the committee.

- Specific Project activities and scope
- Market price adjustments on materials, labour and transport
- Soil topology and topography
- Technical reports such as hydrological reports, project variation report for ongoing projects
- Projects designs
- User department preference

The committee considered the above in determining the realistic costs of the infrastructural projects that were finally submitted to the Board for consideration and approval.

c. Ongoing Projects

The manager table a summary of the Monitoring reports that capture the status of all the projects and summary of the ongoing report that was submitted to the Board earlier. From the report, 3 projects were reported as ongoing which had been funded in different phases and required additional funds to complete them. The manager reminded members that funding of ongoing projects takes precedence and must be done within three financial years but reminded the members of the previous years minuted resolution where the members had agreed to fund all the ongoing projects in entirety to ensure their timely use by the relevant users.

d. Statutory ceilings for administration and Monitoring and Evaluation

The manager briefed members of the key guidelines by the Board and informed members that the Board laid more emphasis on the following areas:

- Provision of a detailed budget with clear breakdown of each component towards funds for administration and recurrent expenditure
- Allocation of funds to staff salaries to be informed by a documented staffing structure approved
 by the Committee with clear job description for each employee and must conform to the
 government guidelines on minimum wage.
- Consideration of other statutory deductions such as NITA, housing levy and National Social Security Fund (NSSF)
- Costing of the funds allocated to Monitoring and Evaluation to be informed by a proper work plan as provided in annex 2.

The said budgets were tabled by the manager and upon deliberations having considered the constituency allocation and the needs of the community, the committee members approved as provided in annex 1:

e. Climate change mitigation and adaptation activities

The committee members considered the above as one of the issues to be considered in the project proposals for the financial year. The committee after much deliberation considered funding of installation of water harvesting tanks for 2 schools that had requested for the same and 100 tree seedlings in each of the schools and committed that in the next financial year they would fund up to

the required 5% as this year most funds had been committed towards the completion of the ongoing projects.

f. Junior Secondary School classrooms

The Fund Account Manager tabled a report from the ministry of education on the need to fund for additional classrooms for the grade 8/9 pupils in various junior secondary school. It was also worth noting that in the previous financial year, NG-CDF Magarini funded for an additional 15 classrooms in various schools which were constructed with matching a shilling for a shilling with another 15 classrooms through a grant from the ministry of education.

The Fund Account Manager informed the committee members that the Ministry of education through a consolidated list of projects from the Sub- County Director of Education had undertaken to construct 17 classrooms in its phase I and 24 classrooms in phase II all geared towards addressing the shortage of classrooms for the grade 9 pupils in the Junior Secondary school. After much deliberations and with the understanding that these consolidated projects both from the ministry of Education and the NG-CDF Magarini are ongoing in the respective schools, the committee resolved to consider Kirosa primary school, Marikebuni primary school and Kaguguta primary schools for 4 classrooms each as per the ward public participation forum reports against the 1 classroom, 3 classrooms, and 1 classroom respectively as tabled in the ministry of education report. The committee also agreed to fund Kaya dagamra primary for acquiring a water tank for water harvesting and 100 seedlings as requested for in the ward public participation forum reports, against the 2 classroom requirement in the ministry of education report and in the subsequent financial year, upon the completion of the current ongoing projects they shall factor in the new junior secondary school classes for other needy schools.

g. Constituency Digital Hubs

The Fund Account Manager table a guideline for the construction of the digital hub and the members agreed that there is need to have a constituency digital hub as it would open up ICT jobs for the youth. The committee approved for the basic model digital hub to be constructed at Marikebuni Chiefs office compound of Magarini ward as there is public land available and this site would also be conveniently located along the road, ideal for internet connectivity and it easily accessible by road.

- Reception area
- Public wifi zone
- ICT room
- Air conditioning
- 6 door toilet where 2 chambers were for persons living with disability

The committee agreed that the furniture and fittings of the digital hub should be considered in the subsequent year due to budgetary constraints.

h. Projects considered under Appropriation in Aid

The Fund Account Manager informed the committee that Ksh. 36,000.00 from the hire of hall had been reported as appropriation in aid to the board at the end of the financial year and the board had included it in the total allocation for the constituency.

The committee discussed and agreed to consider the utilization of this amount under Bursary secondary schools.

i. Proposed purchase of school buses and vans

The Fund Account Manager tabled 2 requests for the purchase of school buses. Quotations were also tabled for consideration in the costing of the buses purchase where the Fund Account Manager informed the members that the costing was based on a one-off basis exclusive of any insurance premiums and recurrent expenditures. The committee expressly agreed to the purchase of these as these buses will be of help for transportation not just in the said schools, but also in other neighboring schools in the various curricular and extracurricular activities.

Final project proposed with list of all prioritized projects

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After a lengthy deliberation and consideration all areas as advised by the Board including but not limited to public participation, adequate consultation with public works, ongoing project, work plan and budgets for administration and monitoring vote, aligning project to BETA, constituency strategic plan and other National Government Policies, the committee agreed on the below listed projects to be forwarded to the Board for consideration and approval.
