#### MIN: 04/08/01/2024: DECLARATION OF INTEREST

The chairman again read out the agenda for the day to the Committee members and requested the members to declare interests if any. None of the members had any interest and hence the meeting proceeded.

# MIN NO. 05/08/01/2024: INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT FOR JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Members through the contribution of the FAM were informed that Circular NG-CDFB-CEO/MOE/Vol 1 (046) dated 16th October 2023 had been received and directed the committee that in FY 2023/24 the Ministry of Education had been allocated Kshs. 21,222,783.00 as a grant towards infrastructure development in the Junior Secondary Schools within Magarini Constituency. Each constituency had been directed to match shilling for shilling the Ministry of Education's amount and help to identify in collaboration with the Sub County Director of Education and the D.C.C, the Junior Secondary schools that would benefit from the amount. The funds shall be used for the Construction of Classrooms and Integrated Learning Resource Centers in Schools with Junior Secondary.

The members were made to understand that this was the reason why the Sub-County Director of Education Mr. Mohammed Barrow had been invited to the meeting as directed by the circular to participate with the members in identifying and approving the allocations.

Members through the contributions of the Chairman were informed that the following schools per ward had submitted requests for new constructions of classrooms since they had Junior Secondary School classroom shortage. The following are the schools and wards.

To note, the cost per classroom had been increased from Ksh. 1,200,000.00 to Ksh 1,400,000.00 because of the unstable nature of soil within the sub-county. Through consultations with the

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Public works officer, he proposed a reinforcement to the classrooms by having a ground beam and reinforced concrete columns at intervals of 3 meters around the whole building. This was unanimously agreed by all the members as it would ensure the stability and durability of the buildings.

# MIN NO. 06/08/01/2024: REALIGNMENT OF PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FY 2023/2024 WITH NG-CDF (AMENDMENT) ACT 2023

Members were informed by the Fund Account Manager that a Circular from the board with reference number NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/Vol II (035) dated 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 had been received and it directed the committee members to realign the 2023-2024 project proposals to the NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2023. The circular was read out to them and members were given a chance to give their contributions.

### I) Constituency oversight expenses and Sports

The Peter Karisa through his contribution suggested that the funds that had been set aside for these two activities are added to the bursary secondary schools vote.

#### II) Bursary

Through the contribution of the chairman, he commended the new NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2023 for increasing the bursary ceiling from 35% to 40% as this meant that the office will now be able to handle the high numbers of bursary applicants that the office had received. He also suggested that for the big projects being done in the financial year the scope of works be reduced in order to boost the bursary vote.

#### III) Climate change mitigation activities

The chairperson through his contribution suggested that for this financial year it is important that a tree planting exercise be schedule in all the wards for at least one primary school but come the next financial year, more funds to cater for climate change mitigation activities.

#### IV) Ongoing projects

The Fund Account manager through her contribution suggested that it is a requirement for the committee to ensure that priority is given to all ongoing projects to ensure that the projects are completed in good time and that the value for such projects can be realized.

#### Members Resolutions

After a lengthy deliberation, the members agreed that for all the new projects that would be funded in phases, all balances for such projects would be allocated in the subsequent financial year.
