



MIN BURA NG-CDFC 03/12/2024/05: MATTERS ARISING

MIN BURA NG-CDFC 03/12/2024/06: CONSIDERATION OF ONGOING PROJECTS


The manager reminded members that funding of ongoing projects takes precedence and must be done within three financial years. There being no ongoing projects within the constituency that needed funding, the matter was put to rest.

MIN BURA NG-CDFC 03/12/2024/07: FUNDING FOR DIGITAL HUBS

The manager informed the members that digital hubs had not yet been established in all the wards within the constituency. On this matter, the committee agreed on the need to fund digital hubs in the wards without one. The members after deliberation decided to fund a Standard Digital Hub at Madogo DCC office compound.

MIN BURA NG-CDFC 03/12/2024/08: FUNDING FOR CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION ACTIVITIES

The manager informed the members that the NG-CDF Act as amended in December 2023 had raised funding ceiling to 5% of the constituency's allocation. He further informed the members of the need to protect the climate from harmful practices that destroy it. The members considered this proposal and decided to do an initial test of installation of solar power to Yakarit primary school. The Fund account manager was further tasked with collecting the guidelines from the NG-CDF Board and capacity

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

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building the members in preparation of fully engaging in the activities in 2025/2026 financial year. They also mentioned the lack of adequate resources to carry out the exercise.
