Mata ward to allocated Ksh. 10,280,000 to be re-allocated from Lessesia secondary school to Kimala secondary school as part of the re-aligned project proposal. Bomeni ward Ksh. 1,800,000, Chala ward Ksh. 5,176,190 and Mata ward Ksh. 660,000 form the distribution of funds re-allocated from un-utilized emergency funds.

## MIN/NGCDF/TVT/5/1/2024 RE-ALIGNEMNT OF THE PROJECT PROPOSAL FINANCIAL YEAR 2023-24 TO THE NG-CDF (AMENDMENT) ACT 2023.

Section 6(1) of the NG-CDF Act provides that, "the Board shall with the approval of the relevant committee of the National Assembly, allocate funds for every constituency in each financial year in accordance with section 34"

TAVETA NGCDF allocation for financial year 2023/24 is Ksh. 175,533,810 the allocation includes Ksh. 9,229, 569 as emergency reserve.

#### Section 27 (1) of the NGCDF Act states;

"The chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency."

Further, section 27 (2) states that; "The Constituency Committee shall deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other

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constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from."

The list of proposed constituency based projects shall be submitted by the Constituency Committee to the Board.

The committee chairperson together with area member of National Assembly, NGCDF committee members, local leaders and other opinion leaders attended the public participation forums with the constituents in Mahoo, Bomeni, Chala, Mata and Mboghoni wards to cover the entire constituency. The team gathered information on community needs and documented them into the ward report in the financial year 2022/20223.

#### NG-CDF (AMENDEMENT) ACT 2023.

- a) Section 48 of the principal Act has been amended by deleting the word "thirty five" and substituting with "forty". Section 48A has been repealed and substituted with "...a constituency committee with the approval of the board shall allocated funds to cater for education bursary schemes and education days, teaching and learning activities and other learners' social support programmes.."
- b) Section 25 of the principal Act have been amended by inserting "...a sum not exceeding three per centum of the total allocation to a constituency maybe used for payment of recurrent utilities costs and maintenance of constituency digital hubs..".
- Deleting subsection (8) and hence repealing sports activities as eligible project by the fund.
- d) Subsection (10) was deleted and substituted with Climate change mitigation activities including afforestation, reforestation, grassroots sensitization and tree seedlings production..."

#### INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT FOR JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

The infrastructural development in junior secondary schools was also introduced as a programme for all the constituencies, Taveta constituency has been allocated Ksh. 7,783,483.00 by the Ministry of Education for the programme, this is the amount the NG-CDF committee should match to enable development in our junior secondary schools. The ministry of education will match the figure of Kshs. 7,783,483. The Sub-County Director of Education had highlighted priority schools in the constituency. The following were the schools identified for funding

- The committee discussed the issue of re-allocation of funds. Ksh. 10,280,000 each for Lessesia and Kimala secondary schools projects that did not take off in the last year of funding. This was due to change of activities and therefore the design, the plan and the funding. The committee intended to implement a storey building starting with four ground floor classrooms and 40 lockers and chairs at a cost of Ksh. 10,280,000 in each school as approved in the financial year 2022-2023 project proposal
- After consultation and consideration of the committee flagship projects, best practice/big impact projects, complexity of implementation of storey building projects in phases and the need to have a better plan to better utilize the available







small piece of land. Phase funding of big projects procedures by the Board requires to have the whole project scope established, estimated and budgeted for and a funding plan established and well laid out to guarantee completion of the project in the stipulated time of not more than three financial years, the committee agreed to re-allocate Ksh. 10,280,000 to Kimala Secondary school for Construction of 3-storey complex and external works including a multi-purpose hall. Kimala secondary school funds of Ksh. 10,280,000 intended to implement a storey building starting with four ground floor classrooms and 40 lockers and chairs at a cost of Ksh. 10,280,000 as approved in the financial year 2022-2023 project proposal to be re-allocated to new project activities that will entail Construction of 3-storey complex and external works including a multi-purpose hall. The total allocation for this project now will be Ksh. 20,560,000 which will fund phase one of the project.

- Lessesia secondary school similar project to be funded in the project proposal for the financial year 2023-2024.
- The two projects which will be similar are the committee's flagship projects to be funded and expected to be completed in three financial years. 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26.
