### MIN 01/13/09/2021 INTRODUCTION

There were no matters arising.

### MIN 03/13/09/2021 NG-CDF PROJECTS PROPOSAL FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2021/2022

The Chairman introduced that the core business of the day was to discuss and approve the project proposal for the Financial Year 2021/2022. He informed the sitting that the role of the members using the needs from the four wards in the constituency was to select projects amongst those requested by different institutions and also approve reasonable costs and estimates. The members also scrutinized the needs assessment reports that were carried out the last week. After agreeing on these roles, the members came up with bench marks that will guide them in approving the projects. These included; -

- Equality – this is to ensure that every ward should benefit from the kitty. The members must ensure that within the ward itself equality must be ensured. All the locations, sub locations, villages, settlements must equally be funded.
- Priority – the need of the people must be primary in selecting the projects. During the needs assessment exercise projects were arranged in the order of their priority.


- Legality – the project financed must be within the scope of NG-CDF legal frame work. It should not be a project of personal gain, political activities or religious affiliations. Any projects with such issues would not be approved.
- Cost – in approving the projects the members also should consider reasonability and value for money.

The Fund Account Manager thereafter drew members' attention to NG-CDF board circular referenced; NG-CDFB /CEO/BOARD CIRCULARs Vol 11 (030) dated 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2021, Submission of Project proposals for the 2021/2022 financial year which the committee discussed at length. He also informed the members of the NG-CDF Act in relation to projects identification and that the available money for the Financial Year 2021/2022 was Kshs **137,088,879**.

The Chair informed the sitting that they would use the Ward Reports that had been prepared after their just concluded needs assessment exercise.

After lengthy deliberations the NG-CDF committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2021 – 2022 in all the four wards in the Constituency:

## **Introduction or Background**

### **NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CONSTITUENCY DEVELOPMENT FUND**

#### **BACKGROUND**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the Constituencies Development Fund Board (CDFB)

In January 2013, the CDF Act 2003 (as amended in 2007) was repealed and replaced with CDF Act 2013 that is aligned to the constitution of Kenya 2010.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2015 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing CDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- ✓ transparency and accountability,
- ✓ separation of powers; and
- ✓ participation of the people.
- ✓ align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.
- ✓ Change of name from Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) to National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF).

## **KEY CHANGES IN THE CDF ACT 2015**

- Reduction in size of the CDF Board from eleven to eight members and introduction of a new officer, the Corporation Secretary as secretary to the Board.
- Obviating the role of nominating Bodies in appointment of CDF Board members. Nomination was restricted to competitive recruitment process.
- Separation of roles of the executive vis-à-vis the Legislature.
- Emphasis on the mandatory role of Project Management Committees
- Submission of Project proposals to the Board by the Chairman of the CDFC.
- Change in size of CDFC resulting in reduction of the maximum number of committee members from sixteen (11) to eight (8).
- Change in the mode of appointment of CDFC members.
- Member of parliament made supervisor of projects rather than member of CDFC
- Names of the persons appointed as members of the CDFC to be published in Kenya Gazette after approval by parliament.
- New structure at ward level

The D.C.C officially declared that the meeting is opened and thanked members for attending the meeting. He asked members of the public present especially women not to shy away to speak.

**1.105 COMMENTS BY FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER.**

The fund account manager went through the provisions of the NG-CDF act and informed the forum that projects can only be funded if they fall within the functions of the national government, if they are not in any way connected to political activities, if they are legal, compliant with the laws of the republic of Kenya, if they are in Eldas constituency and is not connected with any religious activities.

**1.1.06 COMMENTS BY NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN.**

The NG-CDFC chairman briefed the forums provisions of the NG-CDF act concerning bursary, the chairman informed the members that bursary has an allocation of a maximum of 35% of what was allocated and a minimum of that would be decided by the Eldas NG CDFC. He further noted that bursary is open to all members of the constituency and is generally divided into: bursaries for secondary education, bursaries for higher education.
