MIN 4/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The chairman invited the manager to brief members on the requirements on proposals. The Fund manager briefed members on the provisions of the Board's circular Ref No: NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22nd October 2024 on the preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for 2024/2025 financial year. a. Deliberation on the Ward Report

b. Constituency Digital Hubs

BACKGROUND

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the state department of Planning. The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development agenda at the constituency level.

ABOUT MANDERA WEST CONSTITUENCY.

Mandera West Constituency is an electorate unit in Mandera County. The Constituency Borders Banissa Constituency to the North and Mandera South Constituency to the East.

Mandera Constituency is Comprised of five Wards as detailed bellow.

POPULATION PROJECTIONS

According to the 2009 National Population and Housing Census, Mandera West Constituency had a population of 161,701. Currently, the constituency has a population of 220,619 (2018) and is projected to increase to 267,901 by 2024. Further, its population density is 46 (2018) and is projected to increase to 56 by 2024. The constituency is among the densely populated in the country (*see table 1-2*).

These projections are based on a projected population growthrate of 3.96 per cent for the county.

Mandera West Constituency has one urban centre based on the requirements of the Cities and Urban Areas Act, 2011. Takaba, with a total population of 29,298 (2018), which is projected to increase to 35,577 by 2024. Efforts should be made to develop infrastructure and associated facilities to cater for the increasing urban population.

SOCIO-ECONOMIC PROFILE

The main source of energy is firewood, which is used by 93.2% of the households for cooking (KIHBS 2015/2016). The main types of houses commonly used are *manyattā* traditional huts and shanty structures. The main walling materials for the houses are grass/straw and mud/wood with permanent structures mainly found in urban centres.

The main water resources in the constituency are rivers, ponds, streams, earth pans, boreholes with pump, protected dug wells and unprotected dug wells. The quality of the water from these resources is poor and residents are advised to treat it before use.

The main types of toilet facilities in the constituency are pit latrines, uncovered pit latrines, and covered pit latrines. Slightly above 40% have no access to toilet facilities.

In terms of waste disposal methods, most of the households burn their wastes, while a few use garbage pits and public garbage heaps.

The five most common diseases in order of prevalence are Disease of Upper Respiratory Tract Infection (URTI), Malaria, Pneumonia, Urinary Tract Infection (UTI) and skin Disease.

The constituency has a literacy rate of 25.4 per cent compared to the national which is 83.8 per cent (2017). This is caused by pastoralist lifestyle, high levels of poverty, shortfall of teachers, and retrogressive cultural practices like early marriages.

The teacher-pupil ratio is 1:88 while that in secondary schools stands at 1:33. The Primary Education NER for the constituency is 42.4 per cent (53.4 per cent boys and 29.8 per cent girls) compared to the national rate of 91.1 per cent.

(2017). This, thus, calls for concerted efforts from all stakeholders to improve on education quality, accessibility and availability.

KEY CHALLENGES FACED IN THE CONSTITUENCY

Insufficient Education Facilities: Out of the 44 primary schools in the constituency, 16 are high volume, with more than 400 pupils. These include; Takaba, Gather, Rocky Hill, Dandu, Burduras, Darwed, Didkuro, Gutole, Eldanaba, Lagsure, W/Dahan, Sake, Elbofa, Gagaba, Ardahalo and Karsahama. Two (2) secondary schools, Takaba Boys and Takaba Day are also highly populated. *The high population in the age cohort 6-19 years will require the constituency to develop more education infrastructural facilities to avoid straining the existing ones.*

Insecurity: Parts of the constituency especially along the international borders are exposed to cases of insecurity. Border towns are prone to outside attacks as experienced in the recent times. Inter-clan disagreements, mainly caused by scarce resources have resulted into conflicts. This negatively affects economic activities especially businesses where investors shy away from investing.

Food Insecurity: In the 2015/16 Kenya Integrated Household Budget Survey report, nationally, six counties registered food poverty rates of more than half their population. These were: Turkana (66.1%), Mandera (61.9%), Samburu (60.1%), Busia (59.5%) and West Pokot (57.3%).

Adverse weather conditions experienced in the entire constituency greatly impacts negatively to crop and livestock farming. Presences of saline soils in most parts of the constituency greatly pose a challenge for crop farming. Livestock farming is highly affected by persistent droughts. These challenges make communities not able to produce enough to feed themselves. Reliance on food relief remains a common habit to the large part of the population.

Environmental Degradation: The interaction of the community and environment has brought about undesirable environmental consequences which have worsened the poverty situation in the constituency. Key human activities which have degraded environment include charcoal burning and overgrazing. The constituency is almost wholly dependent on livestock farming. This has led to degradation of the environment which has significantly affected the grazing fields and the farm lands, therefore, hampering the productivity.

High Poverty Incidence: Mandera County is one of the poorest in the country. In the 2015/16 Kenya Integrated Household Budget Survey report, nationally, the poorest four counties were Turkana (79.4%), Mandera (77.6%), Samburu (75.8%) and Busia (69.3%). High poverty levels experienced in the constituency pose a great challenge to development. This situation has led to low school enrolment rates, low transition to secondary schools, a situation that is further escalated by high dropout rates which affect the levels of education. This translates to very few accomplishing their secondary school education to join tertiary institutions; thus denying the constituency the much needed skilled manpower to give impetus to economic growth.

Poor Transport and Communication Infrastructure: The constituency road network is in a deplorable condition. Majority of the roads are earth roads. This makes them impassable especially during the long rains because they are extensively destroyed. In addition, 80% of the constituency is not covered by any communication networks.

This poor state of the road network has made transport services to be very expensive hence the cost of doing

business. The transport expenses have rendered almost all resources immobile thus greatly reducing the economic potential of the constituency.

The constituency has no bitumen surface roads.

Insufficient Health Facilities: There are a few health facilities in the constituency, which are poorly equipped and understaffed.

Most of the poor people cannot afford basic health care and this affects their productivity.

Recurrent Droughts: Droughts are common phenomena in the constituency which exposes the farmers and pastoralists to economic hardships. These perennial droughts have actually reduced the livestock sector to cycles of destocking and restocking through the government and other aid agencies. In the agriculture sector, droughts have increased the syndrome of dependency on relief.

Animal and Human Health: Outbreak of both human and animal diseases is a major development challenge in the constituency. This diverts development resources and productive labour to treatment and caring for the sick.

Water Scarcity: Water is a scarce resource in many parts of the country. Ground water, which is the main source, is not accessible in some areas of the constituency. This scarcity poses a major economic drawback to both farming and pastoralism, which are the major economic activities in the constituency.

Comments by Fund Manager on the nature of projects in respect to NG-CDF Act



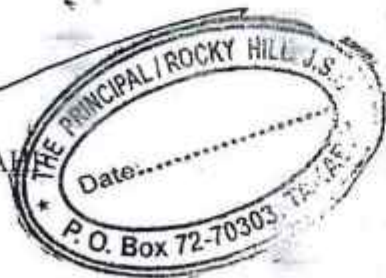
