MIN 3/NG-CDFC/003/12/2024: MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising from the previous Minutes.

MIN 4/NG-CDFC/003/12/2024: ONGOING PROJECTS

The Fund Manager explained to members the provisions of the Act on ongoing projects that must be given first priority when considering projects to be funded. He further informed members that there is a single ongoing project namely Completion of Multipurpose Hall with inbuilt Kitchen, Servoury & 2 Stores. Members resolved to allocated the remaining Kshs. 5,000,000 to ensure completion of the aforementioned project.

MIN 5/NG-CDFC/003/12/2024: REVIEW OF PROJECTS PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The Fund Account Manager informed the members of the CEO's circular Ref **NG-CDFB-CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001)** dated 22nd October 2024 which called for submission of project proposals for the Financial Year 2024/2025 to the NG-CDF Board in the shortest time possible and in any case not later than 6th December 2024. The Fund Account Manager informed members that the Constituency had been allocated a total of **Kshs. 179,441,954.47** for the current financial year.

Members were briefed on the guidelines for project proposal presentation as documented by the Circular sent by the NG-CDF Board. Below are the key highlights of the deliberation on items presented to members.

a. Deliberation on Ward Report

The Fund Manager informed the Committee members of the requirement to submit project proposal for the NG-CDF Board's approval in compliance with Sections 27 of the NG-CDF Act. He urged the members to ensure that the project proposals were prepared based on the outcome of the open forum public meetings and that the submission of people-centred project proposals. The Fund Manager further informed the members to ensure that the Committee anchors its project proposal on the Banissa Constituency Strategic Plan, National Development agenda of Bottom-Up Economic Transformation (BETA) as outlined in the Fourth Medium-Term Plan for Kenya Vision 2030 and the International Commitments and Conventions to which Kenya is a signatory.

b. Statutory ceilings

The Fund Manager informed members of the various statutory ceilings as provided for in the Act and as guided by the Board. The Fund Manager highlighted the following to members as conditions given by the Board;

- Committee to provide a detailed budget with clear breakdown on each component to justify allocation for the administration and recurrent expenditure, Monitoring and Evaluation/Capacity building and Constituency Oversight Committee administration cost
- The committee to factor in the Housing Levy as guided

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- The committee to factor in the new rates of NSSF as guided

The said budgets were tabled by the Fund Manager and upon deliberations having considered the constituency allocation and the needs of the community, the committee members approved them as given below:

c. Climate Mitigation Activities

The committee deliberated on this matter and allocated Kshs 3,500,000 each to Kiliwehri Secondary and Guba Secondary for Purchase of 200 H 124V Power Gel Battery, 200 watts Solar Panels (Mono), Solar 3000W inverter charger 24V, Solar MPPT 250/70 Charge Controller, Electrical Wiring items and installation.

d. NG-CDF financing towards rollout of digital hubs in constituencies

The Banissa NG-CDF Committee, considering the central role of Information and Communication Technology in the National Development Strategy, agreed to prioritize Constituency Digital Hub in the project proposal. In this regard, the Committee agreed to renovate the Banissa Social Hall, previously constructed by Mandera County Government, after agreeing with the County Government over the change of the Social Hall to Constituency Digital Hub. The Committee further agreed to consider budgetary allocations towards payment of recurrent utilities costs and maintenance of the digital hub in the subsequent financial year.

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e. Review of prioritization of projects under normal allocation for 2024/2025 financial year

The committee after lengthy deliberations considering the community priorities approved the below projects that includes the statutory costs on administration, monitoring, bursary, climate change mitigation activities, Constituency Digital Hub to be factored in the financial year 2024/2025 for consideration and approval by the Board.



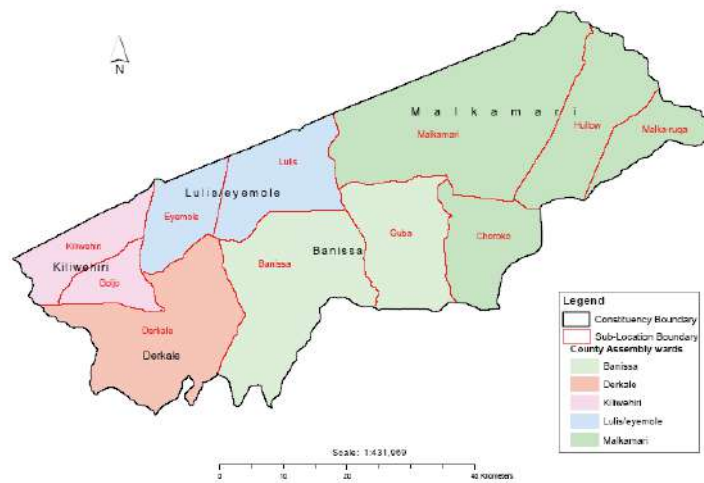

Challenges

The main challenges noted was that the general public did not have a clear distinction between projects fundable under either of the Governments i.e. County versus National, Poor infrastructure, Insecurity (inter clan conflicts & terrorism), remoteness of most of the areas of the constituency, lack of basic construction materials, calamities such as drought, outbreak of diseases, misunderstanding of priority areas and illiteracy. Mushrooming new villages was also a great challenge that was seen as hampering adequate resource allocation.

Way-forward

There is need for a heightened grassroots capacity building and awareness creation on the roles of each type of Government as per the 4th Schedule of our Constitution and on prioritization.
