MIN NG-CDFC 01/05/12/2024: PRELIMINARIES

The meeting was called to order at 09:05am and opening prayer was led by Mr. Hussein Adan Mohamed. The Chairman thanked all the members for the availability and Punctuality. He informed the members that there was only one agenda item for the day. He reminded the members that our allocation for FY 2024/25 was Kshs.179,441,954.47. He thereafter drew members' attention to NG-CDF board circular referenced; NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22nd October 2024, Submission of Project proposals for the 2024/2025 financial year.

MIN NG-CDFC 02/05/12/2024: CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

The minutes were read by Secretary Mr. AbdiwahidIssack Adan. Mr. Hussein proposed while Elyas Mohamed Abdirahman seconded and therefore the minutes were confirmed to be a true record of what was discussed done and agreed upon.

MIN NG-CDFC 03/05/12/2024: MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising from the previous Minutes.

MIN NG-CDFC 04/05/12/2024: ONGOING PROJECTS

The Fund Account Manager tabled a list of all ongoing projects for the previous financial years. The projects were for 2023/24 financial years. Considering the period of funding of a project limited to 3 financial years, the manager informed members of the need to ensure that all ongoing projects are considered in this financial year for completion. 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After a lengthy deliberation members agreed to consider the ongoing projects and allocate enough funds to ensure that the projects are completed on time.

MIN NG-CDFC 05/05/12/2024: PROJECTS PROPOSAL FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The fund account manager informed members that in the Financial Year 2024/2025 Mandera North was allocated Kshs. **179,441,954.47**. He then took members through a few guidelines by the Board where members deliberated and resolved as below.

a. Statutory ceilings

The manager tabled to members various statutory provisions as calculated based on the percentages recommended in the Act. He also highlighted the following guidelines to members;

- Committee to provide a detailed budget with clear breakdown on each component to justify allocation for the administration and recurrent expenditure, Monitoring and Evaluation/Capacity building
- The committee to factor in the Housing Levy as guided
- The committee to factor in the new rates of NSSF as guided

The above was discussed and after lengthy deliberations, members approved the budget as tabulated below:

b. Climate mitigation/Environmental Activities

Members approved the Installation of Solar system into two boarding Secondary schools and One Security Institution since there was no connection of electricity in those centre. Members approved the Purchase and Installation in to Libin Nomadic Girls Sec Schools, Ashabito Boarding Primary School, Ashabito Deputy County Commissioner residence and purchase and planting of trees at Mandera North NG-CDF office block.

c. Funding of Junior Secondary Schools.

The manager informed members of the report by the Ministry of Education on the funding of Junior Secondary School especially construction of Grade 9 classrooms. The proposed schools requiring funding as per the Ministry of Education are;

Due to limited resources against many needs, the committee deliberated on the above matter and noted that Ladeni JSS and Mado JSS were considered in the FY 2023 – 2024 and the project is still on-going. The committee also unanimously agreed to consider funding of Shangalla Primary and Junior Secondary School and the remaining one Junior Secondary School to be considered in the subsequent financial years.

d. Payment of NHIF to the needy community

The committee noted that there was unutilized of Kshs 4,500,000/= that was allocated to NHIF Social Security Programme to cover for 750 household within Mandera North Constituency. The committee did not disburse the fund due to transition of NHIF to Social Health Insurance Fund (SHIF) since the individual beneficiaries' did not register for SHIF. Therefore, the committee agreed not to allocate any funding in the current financial year 2024 – 2025 so that balance in the vote book to be utilized.

e. Review of prioritization of projects under normal allocation for 2024/2025 financial year

The manager informed members of the newly issued guidelines by the Board that required the NG-CDFC to review their earlier submitted proposals to align it with the current amended NG-CDF of 2023. He further told members that the CEO guided on the sports and oversight committee allocations that should be replaced with other projects since the vote heads were repealed. In addition, the manager informed members of the need to consider projects such as

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ICT hub and climate change. The committee deliberated on the issue of ICT and its importance to the residence of Mandera North but the land where the ICT HUB to be constructed had a dispute therefore; the committee member agreed the project to be considered in the next financial year after the issues land have been resolved. After lengthy discussion the committee approved for funding the below projects inclusive of all the statutory deductions as were discussed earlier and as reviewed. Manager was told to submit the proposal to the Board without further delay.


