1.0 INTRODUCTION

Section 6 of the NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 as amended in 2022 Provides that the NGCDF Board shall, with the approval of the relevant committee of the National Assembly, allocate funds for every constituency in each Financial Year in accordance with Section 34.

Pursuant to Section 34 (2) of the Act, the Chairman of the National Assembly Select Committee for the NGCDF tabled before the National Assembly a schedule showing the ceiling for each Constituency determined in accordance with Section 34(1). This was communicated to the NGCDF Board by the Clerk of the National Assembly vide letter referenced NA/DAA&OSC/NGCDF/2022/004 dated 8th December 2022.

In view of the foregoing the NGCDFCs have been mandated to commence the preparation of the Project Proposal for the Year 2022-23 and submit the same for approval to the NGCDF Board. While Preparing and submitting the Project Proposals the NGCDFCs have been put to notice on the following key issues:

- · Basis of Identification of Projects
- · Eligible Projects under the NGCDF Act
- Basis for Allocation of funds to Projects
- · Projects to be co-financed with other Agencies
- Adherence to Statutory Ceilings
- Allocations of funds for preparation of strategic Plans
- · Implementation of High impact and best practice projects
- Construction of NGCDF Committee Office
- Procurement of NGCDFC Motor Vehicle
- Funding of necessary School Infrastructure to facilitate transition to Junior Secondary Schools

- Authentication of NGCDFC Minutes and schedules
- Project Coding through NGCDFMIS
- · Format and Time line for submission of project proposals

Further, section 27 of the Act provides that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development

Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. This Act was further amended in 2022. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.


The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

1.2 ABOUT MOYALE NG-CDF

Moyale Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the four constituencies in Marsabit County and the only constituency in the former Moyale District. Its Constituency Number is 045 and has a population of 108,949 according to the 2019 Census. Moyale Constituency covers an area of 9,390 sq. Km. The constituency is currently represented by Hon Professor Guyo Wako Jaldesa as a Member of Parliament.

Heilu/Manyatta Ward has approximately a population of 21,152 people (2019 Census). The Ward has an area of approximately 50.70 square kilometer. The Ward Comprises Lami, Heilu, Kinisa, Mansile and Manyatta Burji Sub-Location of Marsabit County

Golbo Ward has approximately a population of 29,161 people (2019 Census). The Ward has an area of approximately 2374 square kilometer. The Ward comprises Godonia, Nana, Golla, Odda, Funanyatta, Dir and Yaballo Sub-Locations of Marsabit County.

Moyale Township Ward has approximately a population of 12,695 people (2019 Census).. The Ward has an area of approximately 3.71 square kilometer. The Ward comprises Township, Sessi and Gurumesa Sub-location of Marsabit County.

Uran Ward has approximately a population of 9,754 people (2019 Census). The Ward has an area of approximately 3226.90 square kilometer. The Ward comprises Rawana, Banale, Walda, Lataka, Uran, Golole and Karbururi Sub-location of Marsabit County.

Obbu Ward has approximately a population of 5,195 people (2019 Census). The Ward has an area of approximately 3247 square kilometers. The Ward comprises Bodhoba, Humballo, Garba, Sololo Makutano and Damballa Sub-Locations of Marsabit County.







There is also low literacy level among the population living in the rural areas which also practices nomadic lifestyles. Though the tarmac passes through some towns, the hilly regions have rough terrain and poor roads. Areas around the Border with Ethiopia have security challenges and not convenient or safe for NG-CDFCs to visit and spend nights due to frequent banditry attacks from neighboring communities.
