**MIN 01: 22/09/2020: PREAMBLE**

**MIN 03: 22/09/2020: NG-CDF PROJECTS PROPOSAL FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2020-2021**

The Chairlady briefed members that the committee is required to submit project proposals for the financial year 2020-2021 in time as per circular.

The Fund Manager was tasked to take the Committees through the Budget Breakdowns and computations of the Statutory Ceilings to which he gave the following vide board circular NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD

CIRCULARs Vol 11 (024) dated 10 August 2020 referenced call for submission of constituency project proposals for the 2020/2021 financial year on or before 30 September 2020.

The Fund Account Manager informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of **Kshs. 137,088,879.31**

The Fund account manager briefed members on the guidelines for project proposal presentation. He also informed members on the eligible projects. The manager informed members that all devolved functions are no longer eligible under the new NG-CDF act.

After lengthy deliberations, the NGCDF committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2020/2021 in all the five wards in the Constituency: -

The committee built one unit with 3 rooms for Arapal police post during FY: 2018/2019. 50 police officer were posted recently in the area to curb frequent insecurity. The committee allocate 2 unit with 8 rooms to reduce congestion and increase housing unit for police officers. Arapal location is within Loiyangalani ward neighboring Mt. Kulal.

Mount Kulal is an eroded-down extinct volcano located in northern Kenya, just east of Lake Turkana. The mountain has an elevation of 2,285 metres (7,497 ft). The lakeside town of Loiyangalani is located 50 kilometres (31 mi) west of Mount Kulal.

Cost of construction at Arapal and Mt.Kulal (Gatab) and it's environ is high occasioned by poor road infrastructure which sometimes is inaccessible and high cost of materials, skilled labour and there no hardwares for building materials, most materials are purchased in Marsabit and block stone from Meru town.

NG-CDFC approved request sent by deputy county commissioner Laisamis and Loiyangalani to open up new security roads to curb insecurity and frequent bandit attacks.
