

## 1.0 Introduction or Background

### 0.1 About NG-CDF

This kitty was established under Constituencies Development Fund Act 2003 with the objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level.

Over the time the fund has undergone various changes through establishment of CDF act 2007, NG-CDF 2013 and finally NG-CDF 2015.

Its main objectives are:

- To achieve equitable distribution of development resources hence controlling imbalances in the area.
- Putting up of education, security facilities and other developmental areas.

### 0.2 About Igembe South

Igembe south is a constituency within Meru County. It has 5 wards namely: Maua ward, Kanuni, Akachiu, Athiru Gaiti and Kiegoi /Antubochiu ward.

Current the Member of National Assembly for the constituency is Hon. John Paul Mwirigi. The constituency is well known for its largescale production of Miraa for export and its supply to the rest of the country's major towns. However, in the recent past, the economy of the place has been greatly disrupted by the impact of covid-19 pandemic which led to closure of miraa main market in Somalia.

### 3.0 Projects funding in the previous financial year

The total allocation for the last financial year was **Kshs. 137, 088,879**. The following sectors were represented as follows;

- ❖ 13 Primary schools were funded mostly to construct storied classrooms, pit latrines, renovate classes, fencing and leveling of play grounds and drainage maintenance at a cost of approximately Kshs.30 million.
- ❖ 8 Secondary schools were funded to construct structures ranging from administration blocks, science laboratories, library, classrooms and pit latrines with approximately of Kshs. 21 Million.
- ❖ 7 administrative offices including Maua law courts were scheduled for upgrade but the work had not commenced by the close of the financial year due to late disbursement of funds.

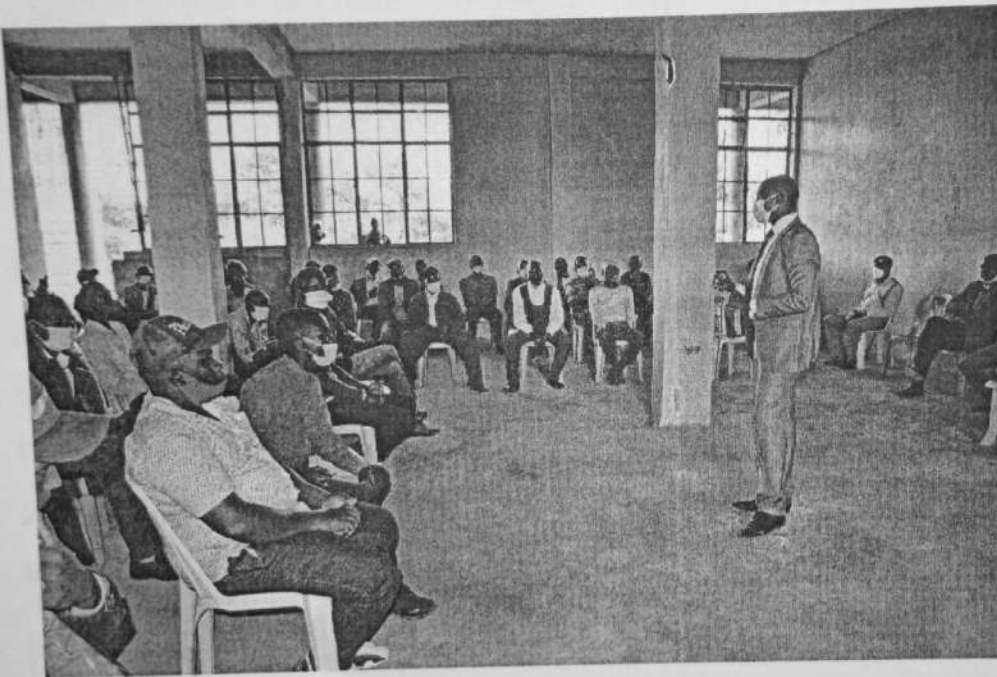

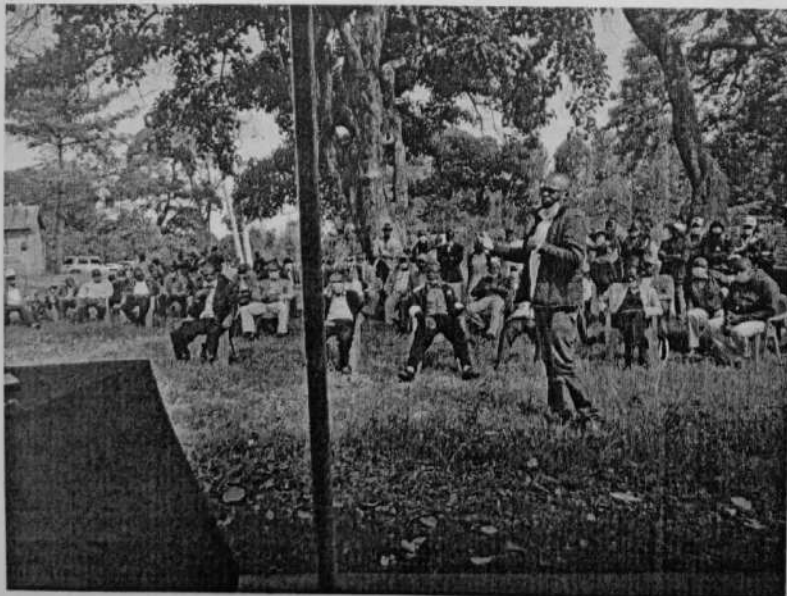
