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1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

1.2 ABOUT IGEMBE NORTH NG-CDF

Igembe North Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Meru County. Its Constituency Number is 053 and has a population of 229,544 according to the 2019 Census. Igembe North Constituency covers an area of 1315.0 sq. Km. The constituency is currently represented by Hon. Julius Taitumu. The Constituency is made up of the following County Assembly Wards:

A/kiongo Ward has approximately a population of 15,049 people. The Ward has an area of approximately 146,50 square kilometer. The Ward Comprises luciuti and Ruongo Sub-Locations of Meru County

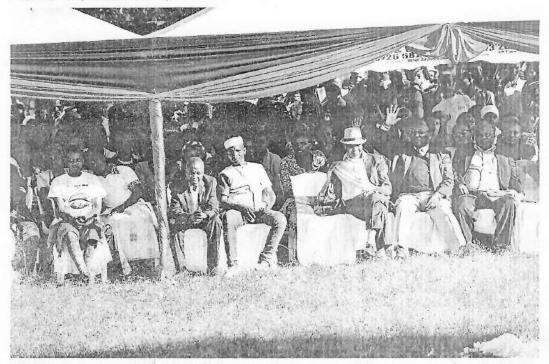

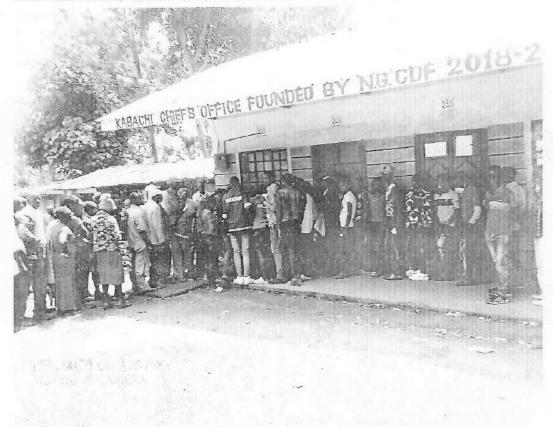

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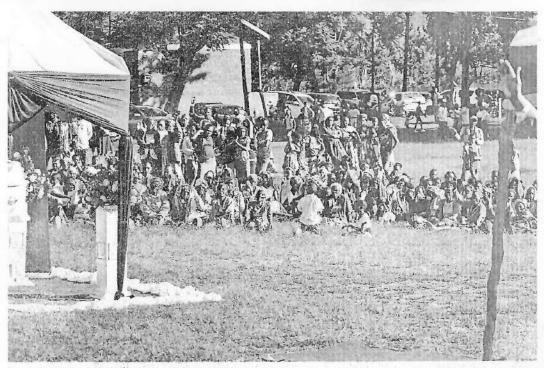

The Area MNA talked briefly over the management of the NGCDF fund in the constituency and informed the participants of the many development projects undertaken in Igembe North Constituency. He cited various projects in the constituency including the infrastructural improvement for Schools and security institutions.

3.3.2 CHALLENGES

The Present Members of the Community were requested to hold sensitization meetings on the feedback of the forums once they arrive home. That is to call community gatherings and inform the people of what transpired at the public forum.

- The Community Members were informed that Issues raised in this Public Forum will be financed during the Financial Year 2022/2023 and in case of change of idea they will be notified of the changes.
- The Community Members were requested to Monitor the activities of the Contractors without

MIN1/IGN/28/3/2023; PRELIMINARIES

The meeting started with a word of prayer led by bishop Sammy.

MIN2/IGN/28/3/2023; REMARKS BY THE CHAIRMAN

The chairman welcomed the other board members and thanked them for availing themselves in the emergency meeting h had called.

MIN3/IGN/28/3/2023; ON-OGOING PROJECTS F/Y/2022-2023 PROJECTS PROPOSALS

The committee was briefed of the need to factor in all ongoing projects as recommended by the Board. The discussions the projects were as recorded below

1. A/Kiongo Secondary School – construction of dining hall. The Board confirmed that the project was initiated in 2010/2011 financial year and was estimated to cost Kshs. 7 million. The project has received Kshs. 3.5 million hence requires Kshs 3.5 million to complete.

The committee noted that they had factored construction of 2 classrooms as priority to the school due to many students' enrollment. The Dining hall being in a usable state, the committee resolved to allocate Kshs.1,000,000 and committed to allocate the remaining balance of Kshs.700,000 in the next financial year ie 2023/24 as per the valuation of the remaining works from the Public Works.

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 Mutuati Secondary School – Construction of administration block. The Board confirmed that the projects was initated in the 2011/2012 having been estimated at Kshs. 8,020,950 and has so far received Kshs. 5m.

The committee deliberated on the matter and it was reported that the project was done to a roofing level and later was burned down by the students. This therefore prompted the committee to consider the technical report on the status of the project to ascertain the required amount that will be needed to repair the damagedareas and completion of the project. The committee approved an allocation of Kshs. 2,000,000 for roofing works and committed to allocate the remaining balance of Kshs. 2,868,047 in the next financial year ie 2023/24 as per the valuation of the remaining works from the Public Works.
