1.0 Introduction or Background

1.1 About NG-CDF

This kitty was established under Constituencies Development Fund Act 2003 with the objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level.

Over time NG-CDF has changed through various acts CDF act,2007, 2013 and 2015 respectively.

Its main objectives are:

- To achieve equitable distribution of development resources hence controlling imbalances in the area.
- Putting up of education, security facilities and other developmental areas.

2.0 About Tigania East.

Tigania east is a constituency within Meru County. It has 5 wards namely: Muthara, Karama, Thangatha, Kiguchwa ward and Mikinduri ward. It borders Igembe central and Tigania west to the east and west respectively and Tharaka and Isiolo south to the south and north respectively.

It's current member of parliament is Hon. Josphat Gichunge Kabebea. It is known for production of miraa, food crops and livestock keeping in the northern grazing areas of Muthara and karama wards. Livestock rearing is under serious threat due to rampant cases of cattle rustling which has left scores killed or maimed year in year out despite heavy investment by the fund in security installations such as Ntangilia and Mula AP camps.

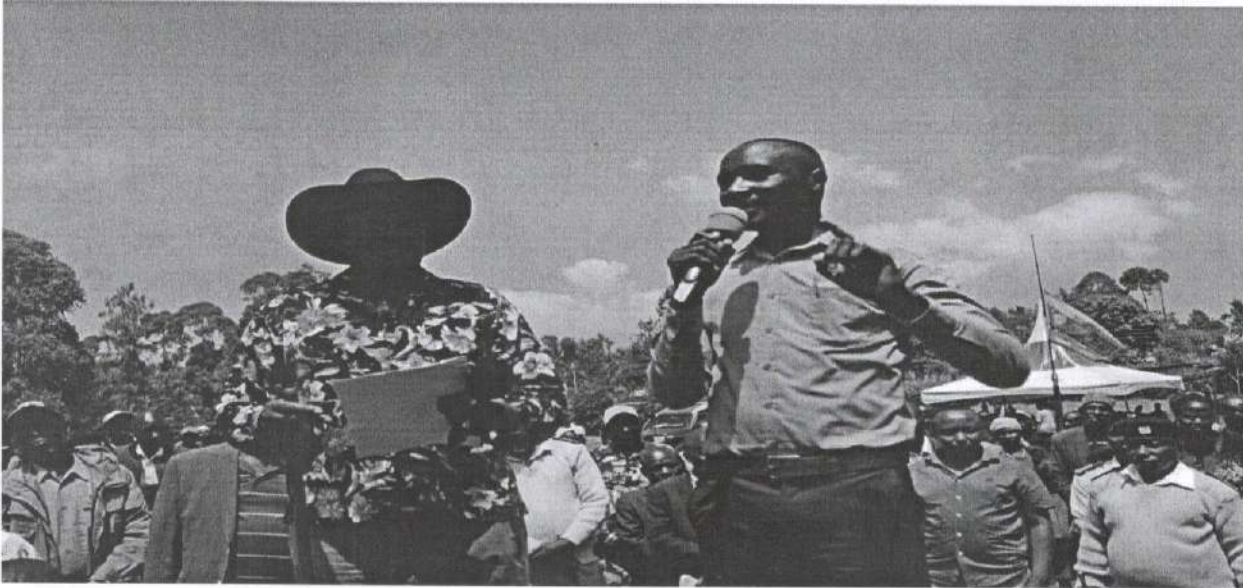

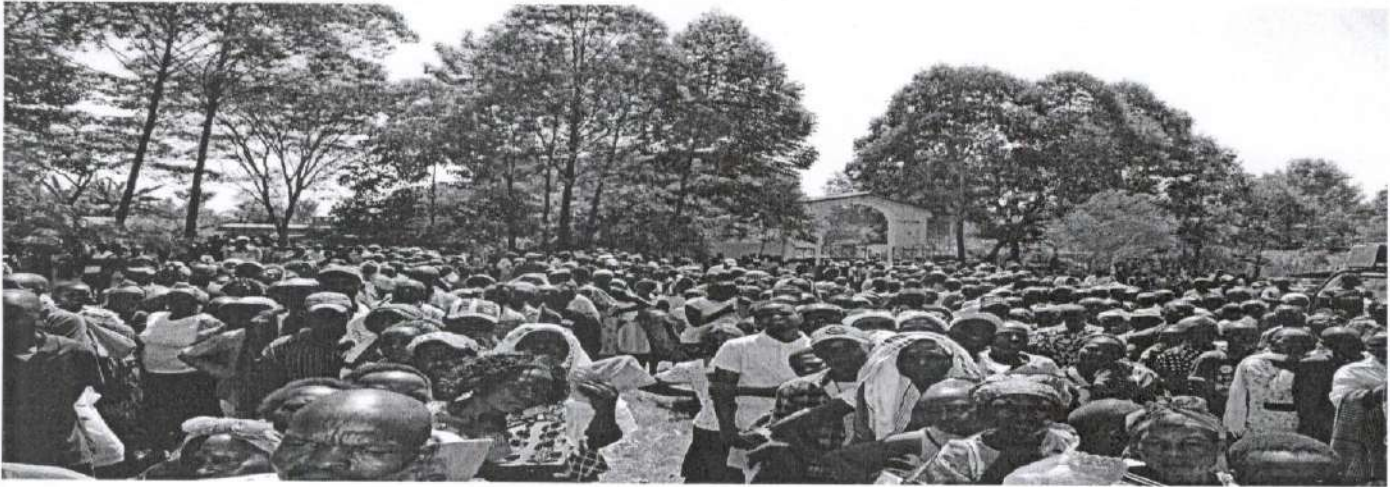
