1.0 Introduction or Background

About NG-CDF

This kitty was established under Constituencies Development Fund Act 2003 with the objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level.

Over time CDF has changed through various acts CDF act, 2007, 2013 and 2015 respectively.

Its main objectives are:

- To achieve equitable distribution of development resources across the country using the constituency as a base.
- Putting up of education, security facilities and other projects like promotion of environmental protection
 activities and sports tournaments including regional sports tournaments with other constituencies in the
 county.

About North Imenti

North Imenti is a constituency within Meru County. It has 5 wards namely: Ntima East, Ntima West,Nyaki East, Nyaki West and Municipality wards. It borders Tigania west and Imenti central to the east and west respectively and Tharaka and Buuri to the south and north respectively. Its current member of parliament is Hon.Abdulrahim Dawood.

PROJECTS FUNDING IN THE PREVIOUS FINANCIAL YEAR

The total allocation for the last financial year was Kshs. 137,088,879. The following sectors were funded as follows:

91% of all projects had been funded and implemented by August 2022. The remaining 9% constituted funds not disbursed from the board and account balances. Some funds amounting to ksh 12M for 2020-2021 F/Y remain undisbursed todate.

Most needy students were identified and given the first priority. Finally the report was forwarded to the full NG-CDFC verification adoption and processing. The advent of COVID 19 pandemic coupled with drought and the resultant famine have destroyed livelihoods making the demand for bursaries to rise sharply as many constituents face the negative economic effects of the twin evils. |

Ward meetings

The fund account manager had informed the committee that public participation meeting for projects proposal preparation were necessary for every ward as required by sec 27 (1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015. After lengthy deliberations, the committee drew a program for the meeting as hereunder;

In attendance; Mwenda Ndubi and Geoffrey kirimi from the constituency office coordinating registration clerks. The meeting was graced by the HON. Abdulrahim Dawood the area M.P. Who gave the keynote address. Among the leaders present were, the ACC Nthimbiri, all the chiefs and assistant chiefs, all principals and head teachers of the schools in the ward and community leaders and wananchi of all walks of life.

D.C.C remarks

(i) The D.C.C noted that the fund was for the national government projects mainly in education and security including sports and environment. She thanked the office of the MP for the developments observed in the area within a period of 10 years. She advised youth to avoid engaging in destructive activities like drug abuse and alcoholism during the festive season. She requested the residents to prioritize the most important projects to realize faster development in their ward.

(ii) Area Chief

The chief thanked the NG-CDFC and the MP for involving the public in projects identification. This would help them prioritize the most important and sensitive areas.

(iii) MP

The Member of parliament thanked the public for attending the meeting and encouraged them to participate fully in proposing projects within the community. He advised the members of the public



who were needy to apply for NG-CDF bursaries whose forms were being issued at the venue. He also cautioned the chiefs to closely vet the applicants before signing the application forms to keep off applicants from neighboring constituencies He opened the floor for the members to fully participate. The MP sought the residents view on whether to allocate the minimum bursary allowed by law which was 25% of the allocation or to allocate 35% maximum allowed by law, the members overwhelmingly voted for 35% allocation.

FAM

The FAM thanked the community members for turning up in large numbers. He informed the members that NG-CDF is a Public fund and should be used to benefit the community members. He informed the participants that the NG-CDF Act required the NG-CDFC Chairperson to convene open public meetings to deliberate on development matters within the ward and the constituency within the first year of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter. He explained that the fund only catered for projects within the security, education (both infrastructure and bursary) , sports and environment sectors. He finally asked the members to give priority to the ongoing projects and ensure fair distribution of projects within the ward.

Comments by the Chairperson on bursary and environment

The chairperson noted that public would be involved in bursary allocation through the NG-CDF bursary sub- committee and eventually the full NG-CDF. She noted that the priority would be given to the orphans, single parents and most needy students. She advised the participants to give priority to ongoing projects.



The meeting commenced with a word of prayer from one of the participants identified by the area chief. The occasion was graced by the area member of parliament. He welcomed the CDFC members and other community members in the meeting and introduced the agenda of the day as project proposal prioritization.

The M.P. gave a keynote address which mainly summarized the role of members of parliament in the fund as legislation, representation and oversight. He advised the community to give him any grievances they may have on the way the fund was run and would take an appropriate action. The MP sought the residents view on whether to allocate the minimum bursary allowed by law which was 25% of the allocation or to allocate 35% maximum allowed by law, the members overwhelmingly voted for 35% allocation.

Chairman's remarks (North Imenti NG-CDF)



(i) The North Imenti-NG-CDF CHAIRPERSON thanked the DCC, the chiefs and their assistants and all the leaders in general for availing themselves for the public participation. She advised the parents to fill in proper details in the bursary application forms to eliminate cases of wrongly written cheques. She requested the leaders to contribute actively and give their projects in order of priority.

(ii) FAM

The fund account manager reminded the leaders that according to the constitution of Kenya 2010, the NG-CDF funds only national government functions mainly in security and education sectors

He welcomed the public into the meeting and encouraged them to give priority to ongoing projects before starting new ones. He urged the project management committees to monitor the projects during projects closely during implementation phase and sustain the projects after implementation.



The HON M.P. attended the occasion and gave the keynote address. The MP sought the residents view on whether to allocate the minimum bursary allowed by law which was 25% of the allocation or to allocate 35% maximum allowed by law. The members overwhelmingly voted for 35% allocation. The residents had many questions on the new CBC curriculum but the Hon MP advised them to be patient as we awaited the recommendations in the final report. He however advised them to plan for the necessary facilities as outlined in the preliminary report eg science laboratories and other facilities. The MP urged the residents to fill the application forms and forward to the committee by the set deadlines to avoid being locked out.

Chairperson's remarks

- (i) The NG-CDFC chairman thanked the M.P.the DCC, the area chiefs and their assistants and all the leaders in general for availing themselves for the public participation meeting, she requested the leaders to contribute actively and give their projects in order of priority. She then invited the fund account manager to address the gathering.
- (ii) Fund account manager: in his remarks; the manager explained to the participants the reason for the meeting as a requirement of both the constitution of Kenya 2010 and the NG-CDF Act 2015. He advised the project committees and the general public to identify projects which fall under the NG-CDF and not those under county government as different forums would be organized by other agencies. He further informed the participants to give their projects in order of priority. The same was captured in the project prioritization forms and witnessed by the area chiefs through signing the form.

Challenges

a) The demand for bursary forms exceeded the members who had turned up. Their names were written down and were advised to pick them from the office the next day strictly as per the list written down for those who had turned up.

Way forward

It was upon the CDFC members to decide which among the proposed project would be funded. The participants who had presented their proposals were advised to follow them up with formal requests for funding complete with bills of quantities for the estimated costs of the proposed projects for consideration by the NG-CDFC.

The area M.P. welcomed the people hence introducing the agenda of the day as an opportunity for the people to participate and air their views on their preferred projects.



The fund manager informed the committee that he had received communication from the board that projects technical committee of the board would visit the constituency on Thursday the 4th of May 2023 and not Friday as had been communicated earlier. Invitations had been sent out to all expected participants i.e. the public works officer, the sub county director of education and the sub county procurement officer. The review of the 2022-2023 proposal would be concluded during the meeting for onward transmission to the board. Staff contracts had been revised as recommended in the previous meeting. Emergency repairs on the NG-CDF office and compound toilets were ongoing and the same would be paid once the works were certified complete.

MIN NG-CDFC NI 055 /2022/2023 NORTH IMENTI PROJECTS PROPOSAL FOR 2022-2023

Following a review by the NG-CDF Board of our proposal and subsequent raising of various issues, the committee resolved to review the entire proposal and address the boards concerns about certain projects. A report by the public works officer on the bills of quantities for construction of a standard laboratory was tabled by the clerk of works. The total cost of construction of a laboratory was ksh 3.9 Million whereas that of converting an existing classroom into a science laboratory would be ksh 2 million. The committee resolved to suspend the 31 proposed laboratory projects for CBC system until a clear way forward had been mapped out for the education system. The committee then resolved to use the 24.1M shillings from the suspended projects to complete the ongoing projects while at the same time allocating new projects from the public participation ward report.

The FAM further clarified that in the allocation there was an A I A amount of Kshs 420, 480. He guided that the A-i -A project should match with the proceeds amount, the member agreed to allocate the proceed to Bursary Special Institutions for payment of bursary.

The committee after lengthy deliberations resolved to allocate the ksh.145,508,083 allocated to the constituency in the 2022-2023 financial year as follows;


