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1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

1.2 ABOUT CENTRAL IMENTI NG-CDF

Central Imenti is an electoral constituency in Kenya and one of the nine constituencies of Meru County located in Eastern. Central Imenti Constituency has four wards namely: Abothuguchi East, Abothuguchi West, Abothuguchi Central and Kiagu Ward

The key development objectives of *Central Imenti Constituency 2018-2022* plan were to:

- a. To improve access, affordability and availability of quality education
- b. To provide security to ensure a safe environment for the constituents
- c. To promote and grow talent and empower youth
- d. To promote environmental sustainability in the constituency
- e. To improve NG-CDF operations during project implementation

Key achievements for the Central Imenti NG-CDF

The NG-CDFC has realised the following key achievements in the course of NG-CDF project implementation in the year 2021/22;

1. The NG CDFC has paid fees to many students in the form of bursaries leading to higher retention of students in learning institutions thus performance

- 2. Release of funds for construction and renovation of A.P. lines and chiefs offices.
- 3. Improvement of the learning environment in many primary and secondary schools through new infrastructure and improvement of existing ones. Bought a bus to one day secondary school.

1.2.3 OVERVIEW OF FUNDABLE PROJECTS UNDER NG-CDF BY CENTRAL IMENTI CONSTITUENCY

Eligible Projects Fundable by Central Imenti NG-CDF

The eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as stipulated in section 24 of the NG-CDF (Amendment) Act, 2016 as those that are in:

- Respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution
- Must be community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area.

The ineligible projects include:

- Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities
- Projects supporting political bodies or political activities
- Recurrent costs of a completed projects
- Personal awards
- Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others
- Projects addressing devolved functions as outlined in the fourth schedule of the constitution of Kenya

- 1. Lack of enough bursary funds
- 2. Lack of proper structures to support disabled people eg classrooms
- 3. Lack of competent workers/workforce
- 4. Time consuming procurement process
- 5. Bursary awards are not assigned to all in need applicants
- 6. Period of crediting accounts to awarded schools is long
- 7. Delay in payment of supplies and contractors
- 8. Poor representation in CDF offices
- 9. Allowances assigned to committee meetings and transport facilitation is inadequate
- 10. Funds awarded to PMC for facilitation are not enough
- 11. Unfinished land cases in various schools which is dragging them behind
- 12. Roads are not well established in various sub-counties
- 13. Poor sanitations in various primary and secondary schools
- 14. Inadequate secondary in most of sub-locations i.e police post are not established
- 15. Water catchment is not improved in various sub location
- 16. Poor distribution of electricity throughout sub-locations
- 17. Lack of enough funds in renovation of classes in both primary and secondary schools
- 18. Lack of enough classrooms in schools
- 19. Price fluctuations of commodities due to high inflation
- 20. Political interference
- 21. High demand for the funds
- 22. Lack of land for government structures
- 23. Lack of committed suppliers


