The meeting started at 8:30am with an opening prayer led by Alexander Manyara. The chairman extended gratitude and a warm welcome to the members, thanked them for their punctuality and acknowledged their presence.

MIN 2/16/05/2024: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

The secretary took the members through the previous meeting's minutes and it was proposed by Alexander Manyara and seconded by Rose Karimi as true copy of the day's deliberations.

MIN 3/16/05/2024: MATTERS ARISING.

- -F.A.M informed the members that she had transfered staff gratuity of ksh.541,944.48 relating to Financial Year 2022/2013 in the deposit account.
- -- That a BQ for Matetu Primary school emergency funding worth Ksh.1,537,846 from public works had been received for two classroom renovations and re-roofing, members approved the allocation
- -F.A.M also informed the members that she had addressed the audit queries raised by the two audit teams i.e. Auditor general and National treasury and the following were the findings:
- i) Unsupported bursaries of up to 11million, with the 35% threshold exceeding to 37%, Bursary beneficiaries did not bring back the acknowledgement receipts after submitting to the schools.
- ii) Numerous cancellations of the cashbook were noted. F.A.M informed the members that she, along with the sub county accountant, are working on rectifying this issue.
- iii) There was a balance of Ksh. 8,700,000 in the P.M.C. account that remained idle due to previously stalled projects. However, some of these projects were currently ongoing.
- iv) K.R.A debt amounting to ksh.800,000.00 were unpaid but F.A.M explained to the members that the debt related to the gratuity that was paid in September 2022, she paid Kshs 688,455 and the remaining amount of kshs 112,240.00 to apply the waiver.

The auditors also highlighted the following issues for review:

- -over staffing in the NG-CDF offices, having recruited 7 employees contract to NG CDF Board 2013 circular which stipulated a maximum of 5 employees.
- The auditors also recommended the disposal of the grader tractor.
- They noted the absence of a bursary committee and recommended establishing one. However, it was clarified that a bursary committee is currently in place and functional.
- -Poor workmanship at Kiamuri Assistant Chief's Office- The meter box at the Kiamuri Assistant Chief's office was faulty, despite the committee's prior confirmation that a new meter box had been inspected. The committee resolved to communicate to the assistant chief for replacement
- -FAM to fasttrack the reallocation of funds for Kiija Day Secondary School, amounting to Ksh. 369,611, and Mbajone Primary School, amounting to Ksh. 1,800,000.00
