#### MIN 5/ NG-CDFC/05/2024/2025: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/2025

The Fund manager brought to the attention of members the provisions of the Board's circular Ref No: NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/VOL III (001) dated 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 on the preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for 2024/2025 financial year. #### a. Deliberation on the Ward Report

- Allocation of funds to staff salaries to be informed by a documented staffing structure approved by the Committee with clear job description for each employee and must conform to the government guidelines on minimum wage.

   (NSSF) and Social Health Insurance Fund (SHIF)
- Costing of the funds allocated to Monitoring and Evaluation to be informed by a proper work plan as provided in annex 2.

The said budgets were tabled by the manager and upon deliberations having considered the constituency allocation and the needs of the community, the committee members approved as provided in annex 1:

#### d. Climate change mitigation and adaptation activities

The manager tabled a guideline on climate change issues by the Board. Rains had failed in the previous year and the committee decided to reduce the amount for the environment to cater for other emerging needs like toilets. 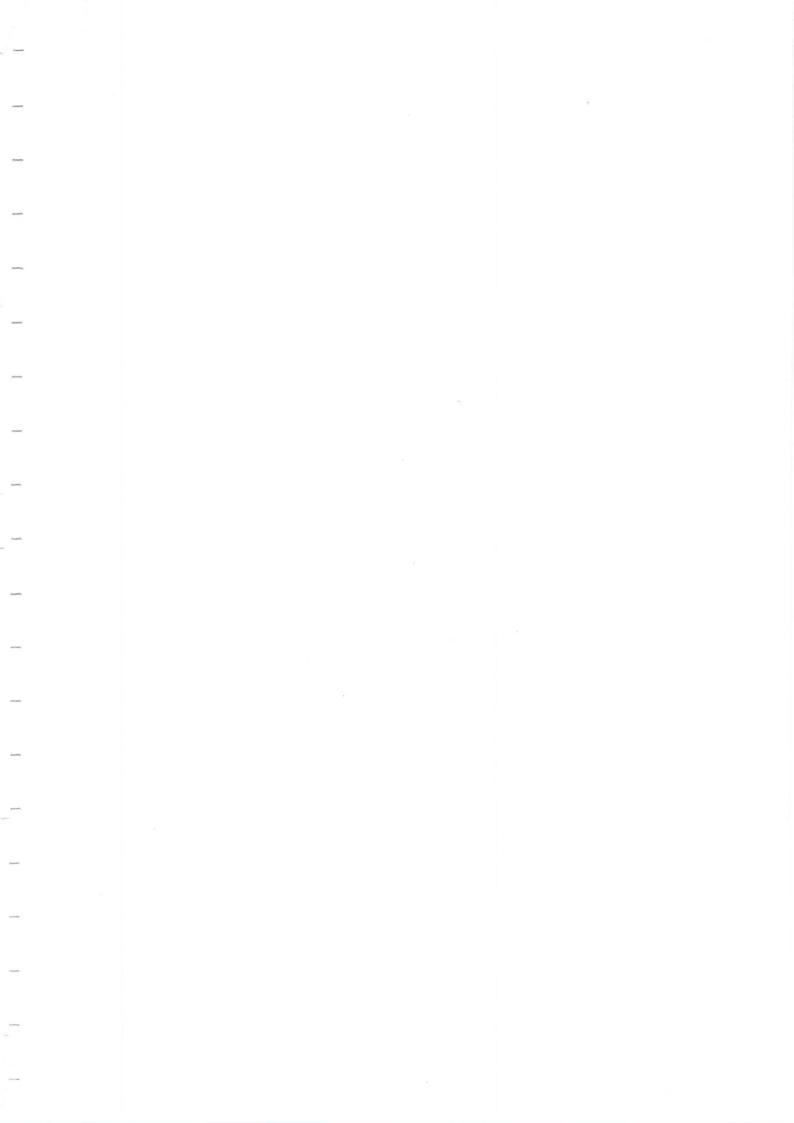

# 1 Introduction

## 1.1 About NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NGCDF) was established under the NG-CDF Act, 2015 as amended in 2023. The main purpose of the Fund is to address the socioeconomic development of the people at the constituency level to reduce poverty and enhance regional equity. The NG-CDF Act 2015 aligned the operations of the Fund to the new constitutional dispensation, especially in ensuring that the law strongly embraces the principles of participation of the people, separation of powers, and delineation of functions between National and County governments.

The Fund is domiciled within the ministry in charge of National Economic Policy & Planning, currently The National Treasury and Planning & Managed by The National Government CDF Board at the National level, the NG-CDF committees at the constituency level and the project Management Committees(PMC) at the constituency level.

#### 1.2 About THARAKA NG-CDF

Tharaka constituency was established in the year 1992 after being split from then Meru District. Tharaka has five wards; Marimanti, Gatunga, Nkondi, Mukothima and Chiakariga. It is a semidesert region enjoying very little rainfall with main economic activities being small-scale farming. Its approximate land mass is 2609 km square.

# 1.3 Overview of Fundable Projects under NG-CDF

As per Section 24 of the NG-CDF Act, eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the exclusive functions of the National Government as provided in the Constitution. Constituency Committees are therefore required to avoid allocating funds to projects falling under devolved functions or concurrent functions as clearly enumerated in the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution. Further, Constituency Committees are advised to consider projects that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity and protection of the marginalized among other values and principles of governance as outlined in Article 10 and the Bill of Rights of the Constitution of Kenya.

Constituency Committees shall ensure projects that do not meet the eligibility criteria for NG-CDF funding are excluded from their submissions. Ineligible projects include: -

- Projects supporting political bodies or political activities;
- Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities:
- Recurrent costs of completed project(s) except projects outlined in Section 25(2A) and 25(6) of the NG-CDF Act:
- Personal awards, except education bursary for needy students and projects on healthcare financing targeting vulnerable families under NG-CDF social security Programme:
- Projects targeting a specific club, society or a group of people to the exclusion of others; and
- Projects falling within the County Government functions or concurrent functions as outlined in the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya.
