MIN 1/21/10/2020 PRELIMINARIES

The meeting was called to order at 10.15 am and opening prayers were led by Rose Njeri Mugo. The Chairman welcomed and thanked the members for their punctuality, he acknowledged the presence of the Member of and gave him a chance to give his remarks.

MP's Remarks

He commended the members good work in CDF operations and their unity and teamwork. He cautioned them to avoid diving and as this could derail giving quality services to community.

He advised them to ensure that bursary vetting exercise to be conducted the following week was done with transparency.

He advised the members that they ensure that they identify the most urgent projects as it was not possible to fund all of them at a once. The projects that would not prioritize would be considered in the next financial year.

MIN 2/21/10/2020 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Minutes o the meeting held on 2nd October, 2020 were read. They were confirmed to be true record of previous proceedings by Peterson Kinyua. This was seconded by Cyrus Njagi.

MIN 3/21/10/2020 MATTERS ARISING

There were no matters arising.

MIN 4/21/10/2020 REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON PROJECTS MONITORED

The Secretary read through the report of the projects that had been monitored in order to assess their needs and urgency.

These were;

It was noted that;

- 1) 95% of the Primary schools' classrooms were dilapidated and required a facelift through, floor repair, roofs replacement, plastering, fixing of windows and doors and painting.
- 70% of the primary schools required extra toilets since most of the existing ones were dilapidated
- 3) 60% of the Primary schools had extra classrooms that were not in use due to decline in population
- 4) 25% of the Day Secondary Schools required classrooms.
- 5) 20%-day Secondary required Dining halls and Laboratories
- 6) 95% of the school required buses
- 7) 30% of the Chiefs and Assistant chiefs did not have offices.
- 8) Manyatta Technical institute could not run smoothly as there was no water, electricity and security

Members resolved that these works could not be finished within the financial year and therefore it could be spread within the remaining years of the office tenure.

With reference to the strategic plan developed in the Financial Year 2018/2019, they noted that most the projects identified had been listed in the implementation matrix.

Members noted that a review of the strategic plan was required so as to list the actual projects that needed to be implemented first.

MIN 6/21/10/2020 RE_ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Members agreed to reallocate;

- 1. Kshs227,586 funds for St Benedict Karau Secondary Allocated in the financial year 2017/18 additional funds allocations for purchase and installation of tank to be allocated to St Benedict Karau Primary School since the school was allocated again in the Financial year 2019/20. This is because there are so many schools that are in dire need of tanks urgently to ensure there is water for hand washing to curb the Covid -19 pandemic. The Fund was to be re-allocated to Karau Primary School.
- 2. Kshs 700,000 allocated for Manyatta TTI was too little and was not adequate to construct a water tower, 2 tanks and gutters. Members have since allocated enough funds since the available allocated funds could barely do anything.

Member felt the need to re-allocate the funds first to 3 Schools that urgently required tanks to adhere to Covid-19 measures of having adequate water for hand washing.

The funds were to be re-allocated as follows;

- 1. Gatunduri Primary School- Kshs 250,000
- 2. Kiriari Primary School-Kshs 250,000
- 3. Gaciigi Primary School- Kshs 200,000

The Funds would be used for Purchase and delivering 10,000 litres Water tank(kshs 100,000), installation of Gutters(kshs.100,000) and construction of a water tank base (kshs.50,000.

3.Members also noted that St Michael Day Secondary School was allocated its own land which was hived from St Michael Primary School. They therefore required to Construct new classrooms since the classes they were using were to remain with the Primary school. Members therefore resolved to change the activities of kshs 1,000,000 allocated to St Michael day Secondary in the Year 2019/2020 to construct 1 classroom to completion at Kshs 800,000 and Kshs 200,000 to start another class up to foundation level.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 3.00pm with a word of prayer led by Beatrice Njoki.
