The chairman called the meeting to order at 10.00 a.m. with a word of prayer led by Dorothy Kiangu.

### MIN.:01/02/09/2020: APPROVAL AND SUBMISSION OF FY 2021/2022 PROJECT PROPOSAL TO THE NG-CDF BOARD:

The FAM informed members that the timeline for submission of project proposals FY 2021/2022 is 30<sup>th</sup> September,2021.

He added that approved budget ceiling for each constituency in the FY 2021/2022 is Kshs.137,088,829.30

After revisiting the proposals from the community and drawing from Mwingi North NG-CDF Strategic Plan FY 2018-2022, the NG-CDFC members unanimously approved the following projects for timely presentation to the NG-CDF Board for approval and subsequent funding:

It was noted that projects in Tseikuru ward were right in the interior and because of distances and rough terrain contractors were incurring extra/additional costs in the construction of 1 classroom to completion as compared to those in Kyuso, Ngomeni, Mumoni and Tharaka wards.

The NG-CDFC therefore unanimously agreed to allocate Kshs.1, 200,000.00 for construction of 1 classroom for schools within Tseikuru ward. In some instances a few schools were allocate Kshs.1, 100,000.00 for construction of 1 classroom to completion. Members were reminded that the cost of constructing 1 classroom to completion remained Kshs.1,100,000.00 in Mwingi North constituency expect for institutions' fitting in the above category as expounded and agreed upon.

The chairman noted that the same criteria applied to security projects-construction of chiefs' and assistant chiefs' offices being funded in the FY 2021-2022 and as explicitly reflected above.
