

The FAM informed the NGCDEC members that the allocation table for this financial year was out amounting to Kshs 137,088,879 and they were required to submit the project proposal before the end of September.

Disparity between project costing

The NGCDEC members noted that some schools were in bad conditions and also the location of the schools are far and the terrains are bad to an extent of being inaccessible by Motor Vehicles hence they use man power to ferry the materials to the projects site and therefore required more funds than others and this is the reason some schools are rehabilitating or constructing less or same classes for the same or more amount respectively compared to others rehabilitating more classrooms and the allocation is the same or less and also allocation for some projects for example science laboratories ,classrooms and renovations are higher compared to others with similar project activities

The fund is managed by the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board (NG-CDFB)

In the year 2015, the CDF Act 2013 (as amended in 2007) was repealed and replaced with NGCDF Act 2015 that is aligned to the constitution of Kenya 2010.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2015 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing NGCDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- Transparency and accountability.
- Separation of powers; and
- Participation of the people.


0.2 About Kitui Central



2.1.03 The occasion was graced by the area chief Mr Mwangangi among others



2.1.06 Comments about Bursaries and environment


