## **0.0 INTRODUCTION**

This report is about Kitui South Constituency Development Fund for the Financial Year 2019/2020 and it constitutes projects proposed by the people from the various wards during public participation which was carried out between 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019 and 17<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

## **0.1 ABOUT NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CONSTITUENCY DEVELOPMENT FUND**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board (NG-CDFB)

The CDF act was repealed in 2007 and was amended in 2013.

Due to a court case, the act was repealed in 2015 and amended in 2016 in order to align the operations of CDF with the Kenyan constitution of 2010. The NG-CDF act 2015(amended 2016) among other things addresses transparency and accountability, separation of powers and participation of the people.

Among the evident changes to the NG-CDF operations are:

1. NG-CDF is now focussed on National Government projects only
2. NG-CDF gets 2.5% of all the National Government share of revenue.
3. Development of Constituency Oversight Committee
4. Change in appointment of NG-CDFCs
5. Introduction of social security programmes as eligible project

## **0.2ABOUT KITUI SOUTH CONSTITUENCY**

**1.0** Kitui South is one of the eight constituencies in Kitui County.It has six wards namely: Ikanga/Kyatune with a population of 36,185, Ikutha with a population of 26,176, Kanziko with a population of 18,664, Mutomo with a population of 24,450, Mutha with a population of 25,138 and Athi with a population of 35,437. The population of the constituency as per National Housing and population Survey (2009) is 166,050

The area DCC congratulated the members for their attendance which meant that they are development conscious and encouraged them to prioritize projects which touch them directly like education and security. They stressed on the need for people to take charge and perform oversight on how NG-CDF money is spent.

### **2.1.04 The Fund Account Managers (FAM) comments**

The Fund Account Manager emphasized on the projects that NG-CDF funds. He said that NG-CDF now funds those projects falling under National government that include education and Security. He gave examples of the projects not fundable under NG-CDF which included recurrent costs of a project, private projects, personal awards, projects geared towards political or religious bodies and devolved projects. He also said that ongoing projects should take precedence.

### 2.1.05 Comments about Bursaries, Sports, Emergency and Environment

The FAM reminded the members that the issuance of bursary is a very transparent process. Application forms are issued by NG-CDF. Applicants then are invited by the area subchief who presides over allocation. The names are forwarded to NG-CDF for scrutiny with vetted forms to prepare cheques.

On environment, every person should strive to plant trees in their homesteads. He said NG-CDF allows an allocation of up to 2% of constituency allocation towards environmental activities on public lands. However the challenge of bad weather hinders tree planting in the area.

On sports, NG-CDF can allocate up to 2% for sports activities which include a tournament, purchase and distribution of uniforms and balls.

On emergency, there is unallocated fund of 5% of the entire allocation which helps to deal with issues that are emergency in nature during the year. He added that, a request for the funding and a photo to show the emergency should be submitted to NG-CDF office. The projects fundable under this emergency are only those falling under the National Government

He added that, a request for the funding and a photo to show the emergency should be submitted to NG-CDF office. The projects fundable under this emergency are only those falling under the National Government
