### About Mayoko

Mavoko Constituency was created in 2013 through an Act of parliament and was splitted from Kathiani Constituency. Its population is 139,502 and covers an area in Sq. Km (Approx.): 843.20. County Assembly Wards in Mavoko Constituency: Athi River Ward comprises Athi River North and Township sub-locations; Kinanie Ward comprises Kinanie and Mathatani sub-locations, Muthwani Ward which comprises Muthwani, Katani and Ngelani sub-locations and Syokimau/Mlolongo Ward - Comprises Syokimau Sub-Location

The National Government Constituency Fund is one of the government's initiatives aimed at transforming Kenya into a medium income economy by the year 2030. It has enabled Kenyans to experience the value of government money and the common man and woman can now directly take part in deciding on the development matters of their area.

As Mavoko NG-CDF our model of operation has always been people centered. It's a participatory approach that enables members of the public to come together, evaluate their development needs and decide on what they want and where they want it done.

Education remains the most effective means to transforming a community. This explains why Mavoko NG-CDF has made massive investments in education sector by increasing the infrastructure to a level never witnessed before. We have built new schools where none existed, expanded the existing ones, refurbished others, built modern sanitation blocks, furnished and equipped classrooms and laboratories thereby generally modernizing the learning environment across Mavoko Constituency.

The new schools example is Ngwata primary school have seen us reduce the distance that pupils across the constituency walk to school and the increased capacity in all schools has seen us increase the enrollment rates. This has been guided by the desire to give every child a fair chance in life by providing them with a conducive learning environment. With the increasing population in the constituency, due to its proximity to the city and expanding industrial zone, the education facilities in the area are in dire need of expansion.

The Mavoko NG-CDF has taken up the challenge and constructed a number of educational facilities. The below mentioned schools and depicted are among the beneficiaries of NGCDF Funds that has brought positive transformation not only to the children and youth of Kenya but to the large communities.

A list of proposals collected from different stakeholders from Mavoko constituency shows that we are not yet done with infrastructure development and more funds are requisite to satisfy the pressing needs emerging from the community.

Last but not least, bursary was a crucial matter elaborated by the parents citing perennial delays in disbursement which translates to students' absenteeism from school due to lack of school fees.

Very many proposals and insufficient funds to meet the demand for proposed projects

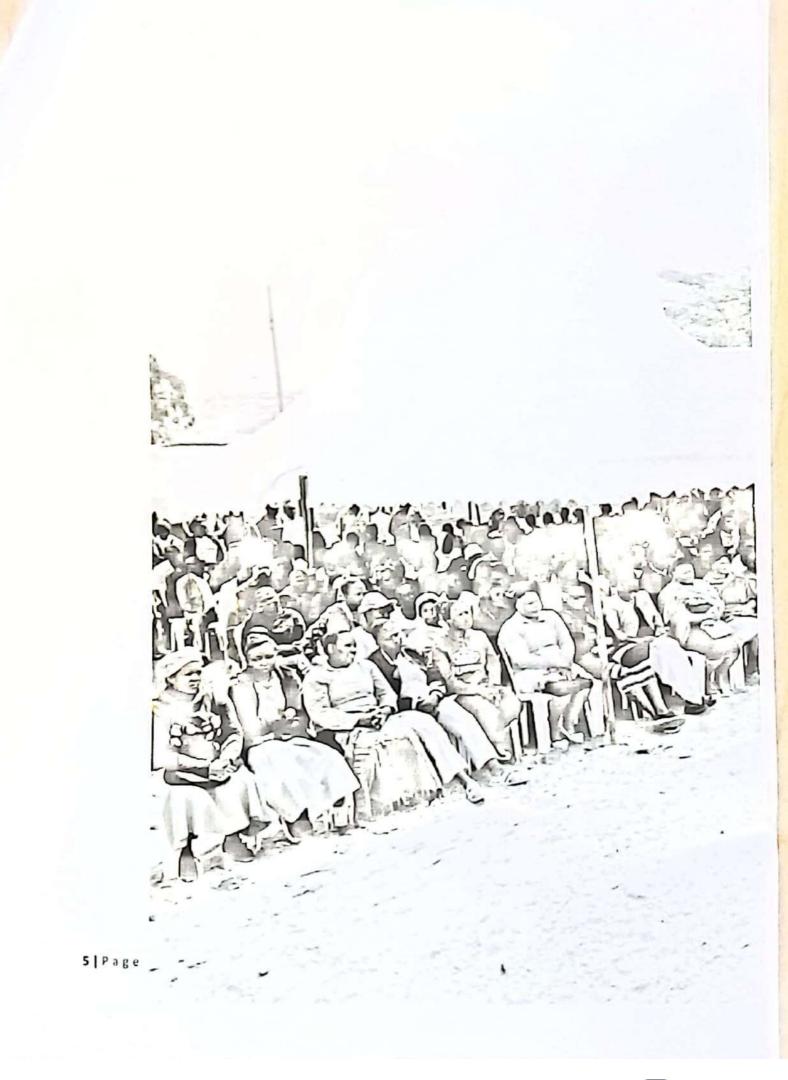

The Mavoko CDFC faced an uphill task in projects prioritization in the ward and especially schools in the constituency had pressing projects needs and the allocated funds could not satisfy all the needs.

Many proposals were received and insufficient funds to meet the demand for proposed projects. Combination of more than 2 agenda that is; commissioning completed projects, issuing bursary cheques and receiving projects proposals in two places in the same ward was very cumbersome.

### Way-forward

Complete ongoing projects and add a few new projects and ensure completion.

Deal with one agenda separately one day at a time.

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The Mavoko CDFC in their meeting held on 9th January 2023 agreed to fund few projects evenly distributed to completion and the projects proposals not considered in the financial year 2022/223 will be carried forward for consideration in the subsequent financial years.

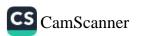

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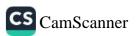
