MIN 01/14/09/2021: Preliminaries

The meeting started at 10:20am with a word of prayer from Simon. The Chairlady thanked members for observing time and purposing to attend the crucial Meeting. She officially welcomed everyone to the meeting.

MIN 02/14/09/2021: ADOPTION OF PROJECT PROPOSAL REPORT FOR FY 2021/2022

- Report on forums held at Ward and ward levels for public development agenda containing proposed projects for FY 2020/21 was read by the NG-CDFC Secretary. The report was unanimously adopted as read.



MIN 03/14/09/2021: PROJECTS ALLOCATION CRITERIA FY 2021-2022

- The Fund Account Manager who is the official representative of the NG-CDF Board took members through the Board Circular Reference NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD CIRCULARS Vol.II (030) Dated 26TH August, 2021 and enlightened members on the following critical concerns, as pertains preparation and submission of the Proposal document;

i). Compliance to the NG-CDF Act 2015 (National Government Constituency Development Fund)

- Unlike the previous CDF Act 2013, the New NG-CDF 2015 Act entails funding of Education and Security projects only which are purely National Government functions. All proposals involving other functions i.e. Water and Roads were nullified automatically and forwarded to the County Office for consideration.

ii) Equal Distribution of Development Funds per Ward

- Kilome Constituency has got 3 Wards namely:

- a.* Kasikeu/Mumela Ward
- b.* Mukaa/Kitaingo Ward
- c.* Kiimakiu/Kalanzoni Ward

- Various public participation forums were held at the ward level and proposal reports were presented as per the prioritized interests and needs of residents.

- Members should ensure equal distribution of development funds amongst the three wards of the Constituency..

MIN 04/14/09/2021: PRIORITIZATION OF FUNDS ALLOCATION ON ONGOING PROJECTS

Ongoing projects to take precedence on Funds Allocation

- NG-CDFC Members are advised to give priority of allocation to all ongoing projects at the constituency, if any. This is to ensure that all projects funded through the NG-CDF Kitty don't stall at all, and thus benefit the Constituents as purposed.

Clarity on other projects earlier reported as Ongoing Projects:

1. Malili Police Post- Construction of a Police Post to completion

This project has been funded consecutively in two Financial Years i.e. FY 2019/20-Ksh. 2,000,000.00 and FY 2020-2021 – Ksh. 2,000,000.00. The project has a Cumulative allocation of Ksh. 4,000,000.00. The projected main project works (*i.e. Construction of a modern Police Station to completion, with 8 No. rooms to accommodate the OCPD, DCIO, OCS, Report Office, Traffic Base, Cell Units independent for Male and Female*) have been satisfactorily completed and project handed over for use. However, other activities relating to the project i.e. construction of a Toilet Block shall be considered for allocation in the coming Financial Years.

2. Muua Police Post - Construction of a police Post to completion.

This project has been funded consecutively in three Financial Years i.e. FY 2017/18-Ksh. 500,000.00, 2018/19-Ksh. 1,500,000.00 and FY 2020-2021 – Ksh. 700,000.00. Cumulatively, the project has a Total allocation of Ksh. 2,700,000.00. The NG-CDFC wishes that the projected project works be done for the amount allocated to the project this far. However, if the project shall not be completed with the available funds, then it shall be factored in for allocation in the next Financial Year 2022-2023.

3. Ngaamba Chief's Office - Construction of a Chief's Office to completion

This project has been funded consecutively in two Financial Years i.e. FY 2019/20-Ksh. 500,000.00 and FY 2020-2021 – Ksh. 1,000,000.00. Cumulatively, the project has a Total allocation of Ksh. 1,500,000.00. As per the Public works Officer's estimated BQ, the funds are adequate for implementation of the project to completion. However, other activities relating to the project i.e. construction of a Toilet Block shall be considered for allocation in the coming Financial Years.

4. Sultan Hamud Police Post - Renovation of Police Administration Office to completion-Re-roofing, Door and window reinforcement, Flooring, Plastering and Re-painting.

Project has been funded with Ksh. 500,000.00 during FY 2019/20 and still unutilized pending conclusion of the procurement process. The NG-CDFC wishes that the projected renovation works be done for the amount allocated to the project this far. However, if the project shall not be completed with the available funds, then it shall be factored in for allocation in the next Financial Year 2022-2023.

5. ACK St. Stephen Kima Secondary School- Construction of a modern dormitory to completion (Complete With Washrooms and Matron Room). Dormitory estimated Capacity-100 Students.

This project has been funded consecutively in two Financial Years i.e. FY 2019/20-Ksh. 3,000,000.00 and FY 2020-2021 – Ksh. 1,000,000.00. Cumulatively, the project has a Total allocation of Ksh. 4,000,000.00. As per the Public works Officer's estimated BQ, the funds are adequate for implementation of the project to completion.

The Area M.P Hon Eng. Nzambia graced the occasion accompanied by the Area M.C.A Eng. Muema and Area chiefs/sub-chiefs from Mukaa, Kitaingo and Kilome Locations.

Remarks by Leaders

a. Remarks by Mukaa Area Chief

- The chief dearly congratulated members of the public for creating time and attending the public participation forums, given their busy schedules and a short notice.
- He encouraged the Locals to cooperate and turn up massively whenever they are notified of such development based events as they are meant to benefit them directly.
- He also appreciated the leaders present for involving the public in matters development, an indication that they mean well for the constituents.

b. Area Member of Parliament

- The M.P heartily applauded members for the great high turn up, and thanked them for their sacrifice and commitment to attend this very crucial event that was purposed to involve the general public in presenting their development interests during funding in the new Financial Year 2021-2022. He urged them to feel free and express their development thoughts and opinions for consideration.
- He encouraged members to prioritize Education projects like construction of Classrooms and dormitories in schools because education is very key and also now that most schools are having their children boarding at school especially in secondary schools.

c. The DCC-Mukaa Subcounty

- The DCC congratulated members of the Public for their attendance despite the short notice and encouraged them to focus on the development agenda because some areas in the Constituency and the county in general had remained marginalized because people are not development conscious.
- He also encouraged members to prioritize projects which added value to their lives and the community in general i.e. education and keep off from mere politics that is dragging the development agenda in the Constituency and the County in general.

Comments by FAM on the nature of projects in respect to NG-CDF Act enacted in 2015

- The Fund Account Manager was also present during the event. She emphasized that NG-CDF kitty will only consider proposals for Education and Security Sectors. Matters Water, Health and Roads have all been devolved to the County Government after the enactment of the New NG-CDF Act 2015.
- She also reminded the Public that NG-CDF will only fund Public Government Institutions and not Private owned and N.G.Os. The nature of projects to be funded are those that will benefit

all general public and not a section of the community. He urged members to be free when presenting their opinions.

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Officials Present and Invitees

- The Area M.P in absentia was represented by the Constituency Manager Mr. Mutune who graced the occasion accompanied by the Area M.C.A Mr. Tangai Munari and Area chiefs/sub-chiefs from Kasikeu, Mumela, Muani, Uvaleni and Sultan Hamud Locations.

Remarks By Leaders present

a. Remarks by Kasikeu Area Chief

- The area chief urged the people to cooperate especially now that the ward consists of people from diverse communities especially Sultan Hamud Location which is mixed up of all tribes.
- He also appreciated the leaders present for the transparency practiced by involving the public in matters development, an indication that they mean well for the constituents.

b. Constituency Manager

- The Constituency Manager who was representing the M.P in absentia conveyed the M.Ps greetings to the residents and reported that he had attended the Parliament Proceedings at Nrb.
- He reported to them that the M.P has the interests of the people at his heart and will ensure their development interests are factored in while allocating funds this Financial Year 2021-2022.

c. Member of County Assembly-Kasikeu Ward

- The M.C.A Emphasized on prioritizing security projects like Police Posts in atleast every location in ward, because it was very necessary to have security around.
- He really thanked the NG-CDF for their good work acknowledged in the constituency as a whole, which has seen the area undergo a transformation in terms of development.
- He however cautioned members on the public on Illegal Sand Harvesting activity around Kasikeu Ward areas. He noted that sand harvesting puts our environment at risk hence negatively affecting our own lives.

Comments by FAM on the nature of projects in respect to CDF Act

- The Fund Account Manager applauded members for their sacrifice to attend the activity despite their busy schedules. She informed members of the Public that the NG-CDF kitty will only consider proposals in Education and Security Sectors. Matters Water, Health and Roads have all been devolved to the County Government after the enactment of the New NG-CDF Act 2015.
- She also reminded the Public that NG-CDF will only fund Public Government Institutions and not Private owned and N.G.Os. The nature of projects to be funded are those that will benefit all general public and not a section of the community. He urged members to be free and present their interests.

Environment Projects

- Members of the Public expressed their worry on water scarcity experienced during the long dry seasons, both for domestic and livestock use.
- In liaison with the Sub-county water officer and the NG-CDFC Members, two rivers up-stream were identified where there has been reported extreme sand menace cases, gabions shall be erected to induce sand stability and control erosion. On completion, the rivers shall catch water up-stream during every rain season, enough to take the residents through out the dry season, and water problem shall be history in the area.
- The rivers identified are **Munyuni River near Mangala market and Kavulutini River near Kwakatia Primary School.**
- The DCC warned members against Careless sand harvesting activities, and People found practicing sand harvesting shall be arrested and handed over to the the authorities for necessary legal action.

Sports Projects


- The NG-CDFC shall organize and facilitate various sports tournaments at the Constituency to utilize the 2% allocation for sports Activities.

Challenges Noted


1. It was noted that most of schools especially primary schools were built in early 70s and 80s and so it was necessary to carry out a complete facelift of the old structures of otherwise consider building new classroom blocks.
- Members expressed Lack of basic information –A Member observed that the people are not well informed about what is going on in terms of projects. The FAM encouraged them to listen to the local media (radio stations) and frequently pay a visit to the Constituency office situated at Kasikeu Market or the NG-CDF Office at Mukaa Sub County Headquarters, Malili to get first-hand information and stay informed.
