- ✓ Separation of powers; and
- ✓ Participation of the people.
- ✓ The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.

## 0.2 About Makueni

Makueni Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya with electoral constituency number 086. It is one of the six constituencies in Makueni County, under the leadership of Hon. Susan Kiamba as the Member of Parliament. The constituency was established for the 1966 elections and, as of today, comprises seven wards namely: Wote/Nziu Ward, Kathonzweni Ward, Muvau/Kikumini Ward, Mbitini Ward, Nzaui/Kilili/Kalamba Ward, Kitise/Kithuki Ward, and Mavindini Ward.




Fig 2 Public participation in Mwania Chiefs office, Kitise




Fig 6: Public participation in Muvau

He further urged project management committees of funded projects to ensure accountability and transparency while implementing projects.

# 1.5.05 Comments by FAM on the nature of projects in respect to CDF Act

The projects proposed in the wards were adhering to the provisions of CDF Act 2013 Section 22. The projects were community based and are to benefit a widespread cross-section of the residents in the various wards.

## 1.5.06 Comments by FAM/Chairman on bursary and environment

**FAM:** The allocation of bursary is fairly done to meet the needs of the students within the wards.

Each ward has a high need for environmental conservation since the terrain dictates the need for the ward.

**Chairman:** Bursary is vetted well by committees at the location level and is awarded to those found to be needy and deserving. To be awarded bursary, students must fill out application forms as a basis for assessing who deserves assistance.

Environment projects are to be carried out in areas found to be in dire need for conserving the surroundings from any form of destruction, either by rains or drought. These projects are communal and fairly distributed.






Fig 7: Public participation in Mavindini
