NG-CDF MIN 101/11/2019 PRAYERS AND PRELIMINARIES

The meeting started with a word of prayer led by James Mwedia at 10.10am. NG-CDF Chairman welcomed the members to the meeting and thanked them for keeping time.

NG-CDF MIN 102/11/2019: 2019/2020 PROJECT PROPOSAL

The chairman informed members that the project proposal was due for submission and already the deadline was surpassed. The members agreed that though during the ward meeting many projects were given as a priority it was necessary to consider few projects which could be done to completion. Members also noted that many primary schools did not require new classrooms but needed serious renovation of the existing classrooms and toilets. Members agreed to renovate atleast one school in every ward and allocate enough money to carry out compressive renovations.

In secondary schools members noted that in boarding schools there was a serious need of dormitories since the rollout of 100% transmission of students from primary schools to secondary schools found many schools unprepared. Another challenge noted was lack of dining halls in day secondary schools and in many schools students were forced to have their meals in classrooms or outside. The members therefore agreed to construct two dining halls in two secondary schools to completion in 2019/2020 budget.

On ongoing projects members agreed to allocate more funds to the following project to facilitate completion.

1. Kavote secondary school-to facilitate completion of the multi-purpose hall
2. St marks Thumaita Secondary school-The School proposed to construct a three storied dormitory where NG-CDF was to construct the first two floors at an estimated cost of Kshs, 20,000,000.The NG-CDF therefore recommended an additional 5,500,000 to be combine with an earlier allocation of Ksh 5,500,000 in 2017/2018 financial year to facilitate completion of the first floor and allow the student in the dormitory by January 2020
3. Kiaumbui Secondary school-To facilitate completion of the multipurpose hall.
4. Kianjiru Assistant chief’s office-To facilitate construction of the office after NG-CDF purchased a piece of land for that purpose
5. Gichonjoini Community hall-To facilitate completion of the community hall.
6. Mutige Secondary school-Completion of Twin dormitory.

After lengthy discussion the committee agreed to fund the following projects in financial year 2019/2020 and consider other projects in the subsequent financial years.

INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilising the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act,

NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

Gichugu Constituency has five wards, namely Ngariama, Njuki-ini, Karumandi, Baragwi, and Kabare Ward.

PRELIMINARIES

The area chief called the meeting to order and called upon one volunteer to lead in opening prayers.

COMMENTS BY THE AREA CHIEFS

The Chief thanked the NG-CDF for organising a forum where the public have the opportunity to front the projects that they would like NG-CDF to implement within their framework.

COMMENTS BY THE ASS COUNTY COMMISSIONER

He commended the participants for their attendance and appealed the meeting to encourage all development stakeholders to have a positive attitude and dedication towards development, since development cannot be initiated and owned by foreigners but by the residents themselves. The ACC thanked the MP and the NG-CDF committee for giving the residents of Gichugu East Division an opportunity to air their priorities. He reminded the residences that they needed to understand the projects that the projects implemented by the National Government are the only ones the NG-CDF can implement. He also urged the residents to be vigilant during project implementation and report on any inconsistencies on time.

COMMENTS BY THE FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER

She informed the meeting on the nature of eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area and those in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution

Further to this she also highlighted the ineligible projects which include: Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities, projects supporting political bodies or political activities, recurrent costs of a completed projects, personal projects, private projects and projects targeting a specific club or group of

people to the exclusion of others. She mentioned about the bursary application are still going on and emphasis the parents to allow the needy students for the first priority.

COMMENTS BY THE NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN

The chairman thanked the constituents for attending the meeting, he explained the relevance of the meeting and the need for NG-CDFC to convene open forum public meetings at in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters and project priorities in the ward and the constituency.

COMMENTS BY THE AREA MEMBER OF NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

He reiterated on the need of equitable distribution of resources as opposed to equal distribution, to enable all the areas in the constituency get the requisite development initiatives for better livelihood and stressed on stewardship of funds by the community members since they are the development consumers and community. He clarified that for other projects which do not fall under NGCDF he is going to source funds through collaboration with county Government and other Agencies to ensure that the needs of the community are well catered for. He gave a brief report on the roads in the Constituency that can be rehabilitated through Kenya Rural Roads Authority (KeRRA) which is under the National Government.

Overreliance on NG-CDF funds by the public and the restrictive nature of the NG-CDF Act in terms of the scope of projects to be funded

WAY FORWARD

The County Government should also hold consultative meeting with all the stakeholders to avoid duplication, double funding or concentration of similar of projects in one locality

CONCLUSION

- The meeting vested the area member of national assembly with the responsibility of appealing to the NG-CDF Board to release funds to the constituency in time within the financial year to help projects development and payment of school fees to bright but needy students.
- Frequent development forums should be held to give the public information concerning the development initiatives being undertaken by all the development partners and the various funding agencies.
- There should be a joint forum where NG-CDF, County Government and other development stakeholders plan together to avoid duplication of projects.
- The meetings resolved that ongoing projects shall be given precedence, to fast track their utilisation to enable the beneficiaries get value for money.
- Allocations to projects should also be adequate, to enable completion of project once started, since if completion is delayed the project cost rises due to factors like inflation and wear and tear.
