INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection I and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, our of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from

Cirizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned <u>stukeholders</u>. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilising the vast amount of information and knowledge that <u>stakeholders</u> hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all <u>stakeholders</u> are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

ABOUT NG-CDE

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies. Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act.

DEPUTY COUNTY COMMISSIONER KIRINYABA EAST SUB - COUNTY NG-CDF Act, 2015 The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

Gichugu Constituency has five wards, namely Ngariama, Njuki-ini, Karumandi, Baragwi, and Kabare Ward.

The constituency is located in Kirinyaga county and boarders 3 constituencies, namely Mwea Constituency, Kirinyaga Central and Ndia constituency

COMMENTS BY THE FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER

He called upon the County Government to share their development projects publicly to enable the constituents be aware of projects being implemented in their areas. He further informed the members that all the projects cannot be implemented at once but gradually hence the need of setting priorities.





He further informed the members that all the projects cannot be implemented at once but gradually hence the need of setting priorities

COMMENTS BY THE ASS COUNTY COMMISSIONER

He explained to the meeting the history of rural development funding in Kenya Since independence in 1963 aimed at fighting poverty at the grassroots level has been one of the key agendas of the Kenyan government. The government has initiated various rural development programmes including Special Rural Development Programme, District Development Planning, Rural Development Fund and the District Focus for Rural Development Strategy with the aim of improving people's wellbeing.

However, most of these programmes failed to address the needs of local people due to lack of political will, inadequate government funding, lack of appropriate technology, neglect of institutional development, lack of beneficiary participation and poor coordination from top to the bottom. However, in 2003 the government introduced Constituency Development Fund (NG-CDF), to fight poverty at the grassroots and since its inception; NG-CDF has had tremendous impact among the rural communities in Kenya.



Prequent development forums should be held to give the public information concerning the development initiatives being undertaken by all the development partners and the various funding agencies.

D There should be a joint forum where NG-CDF, County Government and other development stakeholders plan together to avoid duplication of projects. The meetings resolved that ongoing projects shall be given precedence, to fast track their utilisation to enable the beneficiaries get value for money

Allocations to projects should also be adequate, to enable completion of project once started, since if completion is delayed the project cost rises due to factors like inflation and wear and tear.

NG-CDFC MIN: 001/01/2023 PRAYERS/PRELIMINARIES

The meeting started with word of prayer led Helen Wakuthii at 10.10am. Chairman welcomed all members to the meeting and thanked them for turning up in good time.

NG-CDFC MIN: 002/01/2022-2023 :REVIEW OF THE WARD REPORT AND ALLOCATION PER WARD

The chairman communicated there was need to quickly review the ward reports received from the five ward during the ward consultative meetings conducted early in the week. It was noted that the public was now very clear about the projects that are funded by NG-CDF funds unlike the previous years. From all the five wards it was apparent that bursary funds were a priority. The community requested the members of NG-CDF committee to consider increasing the bursary allocation in order to cover as many students as possible.

It was further noted the chiefs and assistant chiefs' offices that were constructed had really helped in bringing the services closer to the people. The community therefore was requesting that all the assistant chiefs and chiefs should have offices constructed by NG-CDF. The committee discussed and agreed that all chiefs and assistant chiefs should have offices and in sub-locations where there is no land to construct the office the committee should allocate funds to purchase the piece of land to construct the offices.

The public was also requesting for improvement of rural roads. The area member of parliament had an opportunity to explain to the people that such roads could only be improved through KeRRA (Kenya rural roads Authority). Such roads require to be classified as National Government Roads as the other access roads falls under government jurisdiction. The community also were enquiring about water and technical training institutes and they were told that water was a county government project. On TIVET the community was informed that the construction of the technical training was still ongoing and the equipment's to operationalize the institute was already being considered. The committee after lengthy discussion prioritized the projects per ward as follows;

The committee discussed the ongoing projects and noted that the current financial year was special as the committee was supposed to consider necessary school infrastructure to facilitate transition to junior secondary schools. It was apparent then that in areas that lacked secondary more money was to be allocated to primary schools to establish laboratories and renovation of classrooms to accommodate junior secondary schools. The committee resolved to allocate enough funds in various primary school in order to facilitate smooth transition to Junior Secondary. The committee recognised St Marks Thumaita Secondary School as an ongoing project but resolved not to allocate funds to the school since the first phase was already complete and in use. The committee purposed to allocate funds to the school in subsequent year to complete the remaining part. Further the committee resolved not to allocate further funds to Mugumo Secondary school since Ksh 6,000,000 allocated in financial year 2020/2021 was yet to be approved and released. Therefore, the committee resolved to fund Raimu Primary school Ksh 850,000 to facilitate completion of the girls' dormitory. The committee further resolved to allocate Kianugumo Girls Secondary school additional funds amounting to Ksh 8,300,000.00 to facilitate completion of the remaining part of the project.
