As per the Ministry of Education, the committee noted the need to construct the classrooms as stated in the report but prioritized equipping the existing JSS laboratories to them operational. This was agreed after noting that in the sated schools Kirigo primary School and Njega primary school have extra classrooms that could be used temporarily for grade 8 and 9. The chairman reminded the members of the need to renovate the office. The NG-CDFC offices were built and completed in the year 2020 and to date requires renovation to a modern standards. The

Members noted that in the 2023/2024 a total of Kshs 577,300 was allocated for the painting of NG-CDF offices and repair of NG-CDF office concrete gutter which is awaiting issuance of AlE by the NG-CDF Board. They also noted that Kshs 378,000 was allocated for installation of NG-CDF office with Solar panel through AIA which awaits approval by NG-CDF board in financial year 2022/2023. They therefore agreed to allocate the available AIA in the current year budget ceiling amounting to Kshs 11,500 be added to the amount for solar panel installation. This is tabulated as follows:

# Introduction or Background

### 0.2 About KIRINYAGA CENTRAL

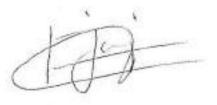
