INTRODUCTION

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF Act 2003. The Act was later reviewed by the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016.

The Fund is domiciled within the ministry in charge of national economic policy and planning, currently the Ministry of Devolution and Planning. The main purpose of the Fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and half per cent (2.5%) of all National Government's share of annual revenue towards community projects identified at constituency level by the communities.

The fund is managed by National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board (NG-CDF Board) established under Section 14(1) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act, 2015. The NG-CDF Board is the organ responsible for the overall management of the fund at the National level. It ensures that administration of the fund is done efficiently and effectively.

NGCDF Committee is established under section 43(1) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015. The Committee is mandated to administer the fund at the constituency level. Key responsibilities are to identify projects, allocate funds to projects, and disburse the funds to project implementation committee, monitor the implementation of the fund and report to the NGCDF board.

REPORT ON WARD MEETINGS.

The meetings were done for the Three Wards of the constituency. The NGCDF office invited management of schools, security officers within the constituency and the community at large. The

announcements were done in churches and letters written to the stakeholders. The attendance was good that saw the presence of area Member of Parliament including other leaders in the community.

The DCC, madam Esther Mwamure welcomed all stakeholders to the forum and invited the chair of the committee to introduce her committee members and give her remarks.

The NG-CDF Public participation is **an important forum** for our community, as it allows us to come together and discuss the various issues and challenges facing our area, as well as to identify ways in which we can work together to address these issues. Today's engagement will help the NG-CDF office to **prioritize and fund projects** that are important to us. I am confident that through our collective efforts and collaboration, we can use the NG-CDF to make a real difference in our constituency.

Today's meeting is an opportunity for all of us to come together and share our thoughts, ideas, and concerns about the NG-CDF and its role in our community. I encourage all of you to speak up and let your voices be heard, as we want to hear from all of our stakeholders in order to make informed decisions about the NG-CDF and its future direction. **So today, allow me and my office to do more of listening than talking.**

I want to assure you that my committee is committed to working collaboratively with all of our stakeholders in order to ensure that the NG-CDF is effective and responsive to the needs of our community. We are here to listen and to work with you to make a positive impact on the lives of our people. Let us work together to make the NG-CDF a force for good in our community.

At this Time, I am pleased to officially declare this forum of the Kangema NG-CDF Public Participation meeting officially opened.

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The Sub Deputy County commissioner outlined the various government initiatives that are related to NG-CDF and requested members to focus on CBC, Environmental initiatives (Planting of trees), and drug abuse in expressing their priorities.



The area Member of Parliament thanked the community for electing him and promised to work together with other elected leader in delivering the development agenda of Kangema Constituency. The Member of Parliament told the communities benefiting from the projects to be vigil and provide social audit on projects. He vowed to complete all projects he initiated and asked the CDFCs to proper monitoring and evaluation of the projects and to adhere to procurement procedures.

The member of parliament informed the members that the most urgent program that the national government is seeking to actualize is the institutionalization of junior secondary in the primary schools. He advised that the institutionalization requires primary schools to have laboratory infrastructure and they should consider it while giving out their proposals.

FAM thanked the Public for honouring the call for the meeting. She noted that Section 27 (1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016 requires that the chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall within the first year of the commencement of new Parliament and at least every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters.



The FAM explained on eligible and ineligible projects under the Act. She also sighted section 49 of the NG-CDF Act where part funding is allowed other

than the fund. She also noted as per section 46 (2) of the Act priority will be given to ongoing projects. She informed the public the Projects to propose should be related to Education, Security, Environment and Sports.

The forum was held at Kangema Youth Empowerment Centre on 9th January 2023. The community through the respective heads of schools and administrative officials proposed the following projects numbered in order of priority.
