#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilising the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that All stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

#### 1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act,

NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

#### 1.2 ABOUT MATHIOYA NG-CDF

Mathioya constituency is in **central Region, Muranga County and Mathioya Sub-county**. It boarders Kangema constituency to the south, Othaya Constituency to the north, Kiharu to the east and aberdare forest to the west. It has three wards Gitugi, Kiru and Kamacharia, administratively it has four operational divisions namely Kiru Njumbi, Kamacharia and Gitugi. It has twelve locations and twenty five sub locations. Politically it has three wards i.e. Kiru, Kamacharia and Gitugi wards

According to the Muranga county Statistics Office, it had a population of 88,219 (males 42,126 females 46,093) as per census 2009 which is projected to grow to 88,499 (male 42,262 female 46,237) by the year 2017 at the rate of 0.4% p.a. it covers 177.3 sq km. the constituency has 24,736 households.

## 3.4.2 COMMENTS BY THE AREA CHIEFS

The meeting was attended by Gitugi residents, NG-CDF committee members, Deputy county commissioner, Gitugi Assistant county commissioner chief Gakoe, Chief gitugi Chief Mihuti chief Njumbi, Chief Kiriti and 10 assistant chiefs. the assistant county commissioner on behave of the administrators welcomed the constituents in Gitugi Divisional office. ## 3.4.3 COMMENTS BY THE DEPUTY COUNTY COMMISSIONER

He also requested them to own up all CDF projects whether they are complete or still going on but while prioritizing the project more emphasis to be in incomplete projects.

She informed the meeting on the nature of eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area and those in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution

Further to this she also highlighted the ineligible projects which include: Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities, projects supporting political bodies or political activities, recurrent costs of a completed projects, personal projects, private projects and projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others

## 3.4.5 COMMENTS BY THE NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN

The chairman thanked the constituents for attending the meeting, he explained the relevance of the meeting and the need for NG-CDFC to convene open forum public meetings at in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters and project priorities in the ward and the constituency.

## 3.4.6 COMMENTS BY THE AREA MEMBER OF NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

He reiterated on the need of equitable distribution of resources as opposed to equal distribution, to enable all the areas in the constituency get the requisite development initiatives for better livelihood and stressed on stewardship of funds by the community members since they are the development consumers and community watch dogs.




