0.0 Introduction or Background

0.1 About CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the ministry of Devolution and Planning. The objective of the fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the Constituency level.

0.2 About Maragua

Maragua Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of seven constituencies in Muranga County. It was one of three constituencies in the former Maragua District, Central Province. The constituency was established for the 1997 elections.

Maragua has good agricultural land. The main economic activities include coffee and tea growing. Horticultural farming is also a major income generating activity in this area. Most of the population also engages in subsistence farming.






