ITHIRU WARD MEETING

The meeting was held on 21st September 2021 at Kandara NG-CDF Hall 11;00am. The members present were Kandara NG-CDFC, Fund Account Manager, Deputy County Commissioner, Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs and the members of the public.

Comments by NG-CDFC Chairman

The chairman thanked the constituents for attending the meeting, he explained the relevance of the meeting and the need for NG-CDFC to convene open forum public meetings at in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters and project priorities in the ward and the constituency.

Comments by Fund Accounts Manager

She informed the meeting on the nature of eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area and those in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution Further to this she also highlighted the ineligible projects which include: Projects
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supporting religious bodies or religious activities, projects supporting political bodies or political activities, recurrent costs of a completed projects, personal projects, private projects and projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others.

Comments by Deputy county commissioner

She thanked all the members present and for their participation for their well-being. She insisted that the constitution had given public participation a very pivotal role in the country as the public are have a mandate in the developments and enactment of policies and bills.

She noted that in developed countries public participation is the mandate of each public and this is a foot forward in achieving our countries democracy goals and towards vision 2030.

She also mentioned on the security issues around the constituency and her office is open for any information that would lead to arrest and prosecution of law breakers and that the identity of the one who will give the information would be concealed.

She encouraged the members present to come up in numbers wherever there is such meetings and also in public barazas in their areas.

She finally urged the members to be also vigilant in the process of implementation of the projects in their area and the to be part of the ownership of the projects as this are public projects and also thy are meant to benefit the public
