GAICHANJIRU and KAGUNDU-INI WARD.

2.2.1 The meeting was held on 2ND November 2016 at Kagundu-ini polytechnic starting 10;00am. The members present included Area MP, Kandara CDFC, Area MCAs, Sub-County Commissioner, Chiefs and Asistant Chiefs, Departmental heads and the members of the public.

Mr. Peter Guchu, the Chief Gaichanjiru Ward graced the occasion.



2.2.2 Comments by Gaichanjiru MCA

He noted that the projects given were all across board. He appreciated the forum and assured his commitment working together with the area M.P and the CDF committee in ensuring there is no project duplication funding from the county government and from national government. Instead the two governments should complement each other for the benefit of the public.

2.2.3 Comments by Fund Accounts Manager

He urged that proper financial accounting, procedure and regulations are practiced in the projects undertaken by NG-CDF. Also the New NG-CDF Act, 2015 is what guides the composition and operations of the NG-CDF.

Cooperation between Government departments/ technical officers is always enhanced for example works officer, procurement officer, roads officer, district water officer e.t.c this technocrats are responsible for bills of quantities, drawings and designs, advising on laws and regulations, supervision.

He advised the project management committee should always liaise with the said departments in writing project proposals and in the process of implementation of the projects.

2.2.4 Comments by Deputy county commissioner

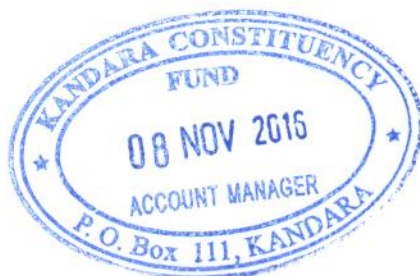
