GATANGA CONSTITUENCY WARD MEETINGS REPORT

FOR

THE FINANCIAL YEAR

2022/2023/2024

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1.0 Introduction

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund is an initiative by the National Government aimed at promoting equitable socio-economic development at the grass root level. In 2003, the parliament of Kenya passed the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act 2003. The Fund was formed as a devolved fund that was intended to enhance rapid social-economic development at the Constituency level through **public participation**. In the year 2015, the (CDF) was changed to National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG- CDF) through an act of Parliament 'NG-CDF Act, 2015' with an intention of aligning the Fund with the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

The NG-CDF Act, 2015 provide a framework for citizens led development to assist the national government in planning and prioritizing the use of its resources. Section 27(1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015 stipulates that, the Chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in Constituency. This is intended to enable the Committee deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency which plays the pivot deliverable for project proposal prioritization. From this backdrop, the Gatanga NG-CDFC carried out public forum meetings where the constituents were given an opportunity to decide the projects of their priority. The Forums took due cognisance of the Ward as their strata.

1.2 Methodology

This ward meeting report come into existence as a result of an intense public forums which embraced participatory and direct engagement with Gatanga Constituents. The consultative Forums also involved members of the National County Administration, Public learning institution heads and Gatanga NG-CDFCs. The area Member of Parliament was also invited in the forums. The Committee collected the proposals through every sub-location representatives who formed the basis of the Ward strata. Each representative was required to present the views of the area members which were to be supported as the true projects by at least 3 area residents. Before the start of each of the meetings the NG-CDFC Chairperson

and the Fund Account Manager briefed the Constituents on what is required by the Act. They went ahead to specify that the proposed projects will be factored in two financial year period that is 2022/2023 and 2023/2024. The Constituents were also encouraged to continue presenting their needs even after the meetings.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

2.1 WARD I (Kihumbuini Ward)


The meeting was held at Kihumbuini market Centre. The NG-CDF committee members urged the community to prioritize the projects that they would like to be prioritized first considering that NG-CDF had very limited funds to serve mega projects that would serve the whole constituency. They were also advised to differentiate National Government projects from the County projects.

The community and their leaders expressed their concern for the following;

- Inadequacy of water supply.
- Lack of good roads that get very impassable during the rainy season
- Lack of enough security
- Lack of good infrastructure in schools
- Projects that would keep the youth engaged
- Projects that would support small scale businessmen and women

The participants then conclusively prioritized the projects as follows;

1. Projects that would enhance security; namely the security masts and Chiefs offices.
2. Renovation of schools and tertiary institution. This was also classified to be in the same urgency as that of building additional classrooms for some schools and institution.
3. Building roads to serve some of the areas that had no good roads.



The NG-CDF Committee Chairperson expressed his gratitude to the contributions that were received and thanked everyone who had turned up for the meeting. He assured them that as soon as the money is given to NG-CDF they should be ready to front the various PMCs for the projects they had pinpointed so that the projects are supervised well until completion.

2.2 WARD II(Kariara)

The meeting was held at Gatura Shopping Centre with attendance from various communities and government leadership and the community. After long deliberations, the following Sectors of concern were put forward by the Ward residents;

- Inadequacy of water supply.
- Lack of enough security
- Poor infrastructure in Primary and Secondary schools
- Poor Road infrastructure

The NG-CDF committee members guaranteed the community that through various proposals sent to their office they had noted some of the concerns. The Chairperson assured the Ward residents that all the concerns were being taken for prioritization.

The area Chairperson also assured the community that the issue of Road network was a big problem in the whole of the constituency since the issue was being addressed by the national government they had no need to worry anymore since in a very short time they would all have some of the networks linked.

The participants then conclusively prioritized the projects as follows;

1. Renovation of schools, Construction of Dining Halls, Classrooms, Kitchen, Pit-latrines and purchase of land for primary and secondary school.
2. Construction and Renovation of Chiefs, Sub-chief and Police posts.



The NG-CDF Committee members expressed their gratitude to the contributions that were received and thanked everyone who had turned up for the meeting.

2.3 WARD III (Mugumoini Ward)

The meeting was held at Gatunyu Market with attendance from various community, County and government leaders where they expressed their gratitude for the activity. This, as they affirmed, will enable the projects have strong support of the community. The Constituents urged the NG-CDF committee to consider increasing the amount of bursary amount awarded to the ward since they needed to support more needy students.

The NG-CDF Chairperson pointed out to the residents that his committee had previously maximized the budget amount for bursary. He went on to state that every year there was more and more needs for more money to be allocated but the limiting factor was that NG-CDF had a ceiling to how much can be budgeted for the bursary according to the amount given to any constituency. He however promised that the committee would come up with a good strategy that will see the bright needy students get enough bursaries to sustain learning to completion.


The participants then conclusively prioritized the projects as follows;

1. Renovation of schools, Construction of Dining Halls, Classrooms, Kitchen, Pit-latrines and purchase of land for primary and secondary school.
2. Construction and Renovation of Chiefs, Sub-chief and Police posts.

The NG-CDF Committee members expressed their gratitude to the contributions that were received and thanked everyone who had turned up for the meeting.

2.4 WARD IV(Gatanga Ward)

The meeting was held at Kirwara Open Market with attendance from the community, government's representatives and county representatives. The community leaders congratulated the NG-CDF for



the work they had done in changing the look of the schools. According to the residents, had gone a long way in improving the education standards and also the hygiene of the students. They also thanked the NG-CDF committee for the initiative to implement projects that are community initiated.

The Ward residents however challenged the committee to continue in the same spirit of improving the schools for their pupils and the security of the remaining shopping areas that had not benefited from the erection of security masts. They left it to the committee to prioritize which shopping areas to help with the security masts and which primary schools to renovate first since the list of schools was very long to have all of them done with the amount given to NG-CDFC.

It was therefore agreed that;

1. The rest of the projects to be prioritized according to the level of need and urgency were to be the solar powered security masts and the renovation of schools.
2. Construction of both Secondary and primary School classrooms to be given priority

2.5 WARD V(Kakuzi/Mitumbiri Ward)

The meeting was held at Kenyatta Farm area with attendance from the community, government representatives, NG-CDF committee members and County officials. They now requested the NG-CDF committee to slot in some Dormitory for girls, Borehole, Administration Block, classrooms.

The other concern that was shown was the condition of roads in the area which they complained that during the rainy seasons the roads were becoming impassable and so they needed the NG-CDF committee to consider if the funds were enough to accommodate such. The NG-CDF Chairperson in response said that the national government had promised to work on some of the roads in the constituency and some of the roads were still work in progress. He stressed on the point that the funds given to NG-CDF are very limited considering all the needs of the community in the constituency. He added that the priority projects in all the wards visited so far for the ward meetings



there had been general consensus on prioritizing security, education and markets, which was making it difficult for the committee to think about roads since the funds were very limiting.

It was therefore agreed that the following would be considered for funding for financial year 2022-2024;

1. Security infrastructure
2. Projects that would enhance security of the area
3. Projects that would ensure the youth are preoccupied and gain skills that would help them earn a living.
4. Improvement of schools infrastructure.

2.6 WARD VI (Ithanga Ward)

The meeting was held at Ithanga shopping Centre with attendance from the community members, National government administration representatives and the county government officials. Several community members thanked the NG-CDF committee and the NG-CDF listening to their need for help in the area of security in the past and they had since seen a great change since CDF funded the erection of the security mast in the shopping Centre. They however pointed out that some of the masts had gone off.

They talked about having a challenge in consideration of projects in the past, which had made the area remain behind in terms of community development mainly in infrastructure. They however challenged NG-CDF committee to continue in the same spirit since there was a lot that needed to be done in that area for it to catch up with the rest of the country. Through a local community leader chosen at the venue of the meeting, they highlighted the following to be their major concerns;

1. Lack of access to water
2. Lack of access to markets



3. Lack of good schools amenities to foster quality education
4. High poverty levels resulting to high dependency on bursary
5. High unemployment rate to their youth
6. Lack of adequate Security Infrastructure.

During the meeting the residents were also briefly trained on the following topics by the relevant Government Ministry officials from the sub-county;

- i) Giving CDF Feedback and Complains
- ii) Drug and Substance abuse in Gatanga Constituency
- iii) How to apply for Bursary in NG-CDF.

The areas that it was agreed that would be given sole responsibility of CDF to handle were the following;

1. Engagement of their youth through various sports tournaments and skills acquisition
2. Renovation of schools and improvement of school amenities
3. Sponsorship of bright but needy students into Secondary Schools and Tertiary institutions
4. Construction of Chief, Sub-Chief and Police post.

2.7 CONCLUSION/WAY FORWARD

The NG-CDFC after analyzing the comments and contribution of the various ward meetings were able to conclusively decide that the areas of concern for the community were as follows;

1. Improving the quality of education in the constituency through improvement of the learning facilities and regular stakeholder's meetings in that sector to continuously agree on a way to improve the education standards in the constituency.
2. Continuously improve the security of the shopping centres through lighting the areas and any other way that would see the security of the various places improve.



3. Full sponsorship of bright but needy students throughout their school time.
4. Engagement of the youth through sports and any other skill acquisition activity.
5. Improvement of trading activities through improvement of trade infrastructure.

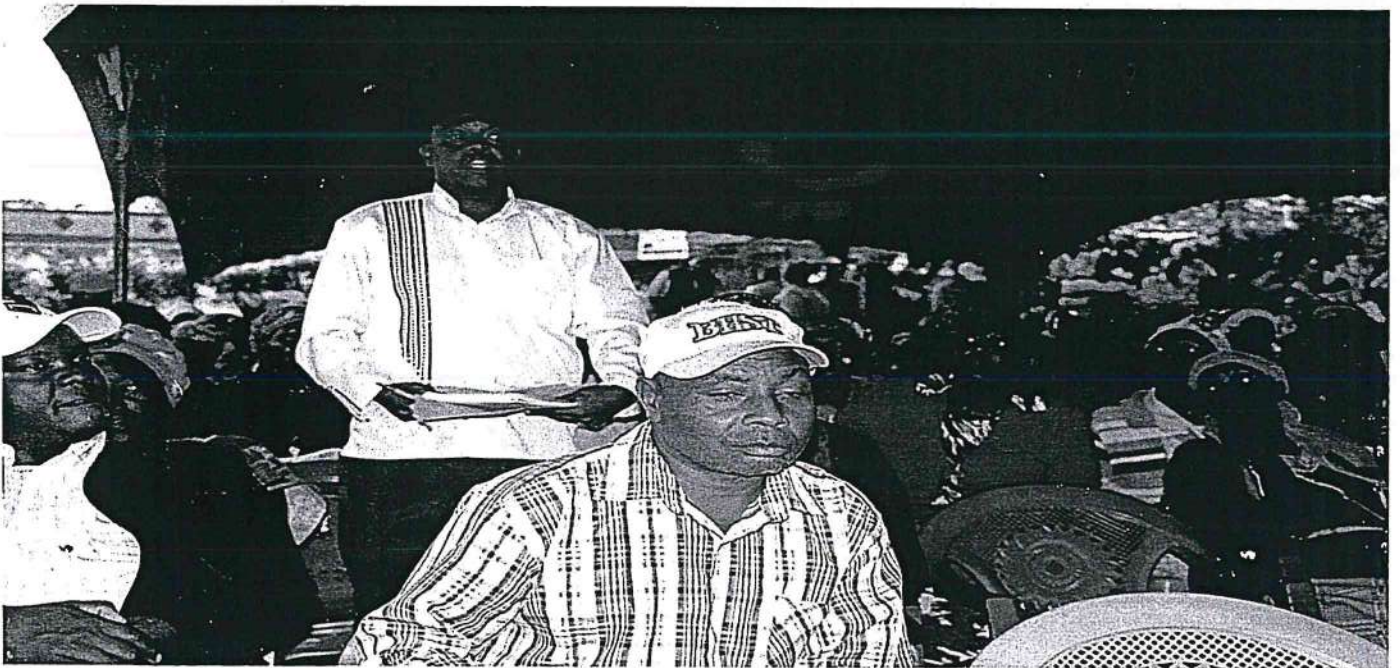


