1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Fund Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a New Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene an open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Development Fund Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.



1.1 ABOUT GATUNDU NORTH NG-CDF

GATUNDU NORTH Constituency as a whole was formed from the former GATUNDU Constituency and has four wards, namely Mangu, Chania, Githobokoni and Gituamba Ward.

The constituency is located in Kiambu county and boarders 4 constituencies, namely Gatundu South, Thika, Gatanga and Juja.



3.1.1.1 PRELIMINARIES/ COMMENTS BY THE DEPUTY COUNTY COMMISSIONER.

The DCC called the meeting to order and called upon the area chief to lead in opening prayers.

3.1.1.2. COMMENTS BY THE AREA CHIEFS

The meeting was attended by two chiefs from Mang'u and Karure Locations in Mang'u Ward. Who jointly thanked the NG-CDF for organizing a forum where the public have the opportunity to front the projects that they would like NG-CDF to implement within their framework and asked the team to continue helping them in the area of security. They emphasized on the need to engage the school drop out in activities that will keep them busy thus avoiding other acts as thefts, that is very rampant.

3.1.1.3 COMMENTS BY THE NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN

The chairman thanked the constituents for attending the meeting; he explained the relevance of the meeting and the need for NG-CDFC to convene open forum public meetings at in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters and project priorities in the ward and the constituency.

He introduced other members of the committee and the Fund Account Manager, and gave her chance to highlight members of public on the eligible projects fundable by NGCDF. And in response to the chief's request of engaging the school drop outs, the chairman promised to support them and suggested activities such as computer colleges, catering, tailoring and driving.



3.1.1.4. COMMENTS BY THE AREA MEMBER OF NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

He talked about the fact that The Constituency is so much behind in development, lacking even a single branch of a bank and other government services.

He emphasized so much on the need to focus on security in the area, school feeding program and transition to Junior secondary. He requested the CDFC to prioritize the security projects, kitchen and Dining Halls in schools and infrastructure needed for transition to junior secondary schools. He also added on the need to allocating some funds to colleges like driving schools, computer colleges and tailoring, as this will not only avoid vices like theft but also help them create jobs for themselves at the end of the courses. He reiterated on the need of equitable distribution of resources as opposed to equal distribution, to enable all the areas in the constituency get the requisite development initiatives for better livelihood and stressed on stewardship of funds by the community members since they are the development consumers and community watch dogs.

He responded on the other projects that are not fundable by NGCDF.







development in the constituency, and the overall aim of this is to ensure active participation of people in the achievement of sustainable development.


3.1.3.2. COMMENTS BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF AREA MEMBER OF NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.



4. CHALLENGES DURING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ACROSS THE WARDS.

-All the principals and head teachers express their needs as urgent.

-Members of public expressed concern on the restrictive nature of the projects fundable

-Late disbursement of project funds lead to projects not being implemented in time which lead to rise in project costs due to factors like inflation and bursaries not awarded to students when the schools open, hence students and pupils retention in learning institutions is greatly affected negatively.

-It was noted that there is overreliance on NG-CDF funds by the community, and politicians taking credit for the job well done by NG-CDF

5. CONCLUSION/WAY FORWARD

Frequent development forums should be held to give the public information concerning the development initiatives being undertaken by all the development partners and the various funding agencies.

project implementation should be done through Project Management Committee PMC to address the issues of rude contractor. The CDFC are urged to spread the projects across the wards. The meeting resolved that all the funds disbursed to projects be spent judiciously to promote value for money and boost the livelihood of the residents.

The NGCDFC agreed to visit all the schools and police stations in order to realize their different needs. The visit will also help them realize there are incomplete project the needs to be completed before beginning new projects.

Allocations to projects should also be adequate, to enable completion of project once started, since if completion is delayed the project cost rises due to factors like inflation and wear and tear.



The meetings resolved that ongoing project shall be given precedence, to fast track their utilization to enable the beneficiaries get value for money.


The committee also realized that the best people to engage for bursary allocations to pupils and students are teachers, head teachers, principals and area chiefs, since they are the ones who know their parents and guardians back home and understand their need more.

The meeting resolved that funding of projects that have been devolved should be avoided as per the NG-CDF Act 2015, hence the area Member of County Assembly should also organize a forum where the constituents will propose the projects that the county government can implement in their areas

NGCDFC resolved after public participation and shortlisting ward priorities they will visit all the projects with sub county works officer and come up with estimated cost for all the prioritized projects before proceeding to another ward.

The NG-CDF Board should facilitate timely disbursement of funds to constituencies in order to fast track development initiatives. The meeting vested the area member of national assembly with the responsibility of appealing to the NG-CDF Board to release funds to the constituency in time within the financial year to help projects development and payment of school fees to bright but needy students.

There should be a joint forum where NG-CDF, County Government and other development stakeholders plan together to avoid duplication of projects. Projects promoting youth's involvement should also be funded
