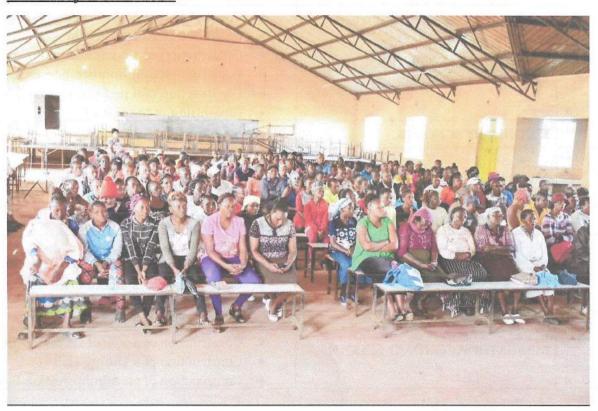

MIN 16/1/TT/NGCDF/FY2022/2023: OPENINNG PRAYERS

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MIN 17/1/TT/NGCDF/FY2022/2023: CHAIRMAN'S OPENING REMARKS

The chairman invited the members to the meeting and informed them that the deliberations were mainly to prioritize and approve the project proposals for the F/Y 2022/2023. The chairman thanked the members for availing themselves to the meeting especially after having the handover exercise and public participation exercise continuously without taking rest.

MIN 18/1/TT/NG-CDF/FY2022/2023: PUBLIC PARTICIPATION FEEDBACK

The chairman gave each member an opportunity to give feedback on how the public participation exercise went. Each member appreciated the public who throughout the 7 forums conducted came in large numbers to give their proposals. The members also noted that Kamenu ward is very large and even though three meetings were conducted in the

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ward, more people felt that there was need to diversify the meetings to have 5 of them. The members however appreciated their individual effort in making the exercise a success.

MIN 19/1/TT/NGCDF/FY2022/2023: ONGOING PROJECTS TO BE ALLOCATED FUNDS

As noted during the handing/taking over exercise by the NG-CDFC conducted on 3rd January 2023 during the projects visit by both the outgoing and incoming NG-CDFC members, there were those projects that were ongoing and needed to be allocated funds to complete them. The Fund account manager further informed the members that the guidelines provided by the Board for the Preparation of the proposals required that all the ongoing projects be allocated funds for completion of the said projects. The fund account manager further informed the members that Chania Boys High School was not reported as ongoing earlier because the initial proposal of 3 offices and toilets in 2021/2022 F/Y would have been completed but the school increased and financed the additional scope of works up to the walling level. Also, Broadway Secondary School was not reported as ongoing because the proposed construction of laboratory structure in FY 2022/2023 was completed but wouldn't be of good use unless equipped hence the consideration for equipping in the FY 2022/2023 proposal. This agenda was deliberated at length and the projects deemed ongoing were allocated funds as follows;

MIN 20/1/TT/NGCDF/FY2022/2023: NG-CDFC OFFICE AND STRATEGIC PLAN

NG-CDFC OFFICE

The fund account manager read through the circular from the board that stipulated that any constituency that was yet to construct a permanent NG-CDFC Office was required to set aside funds in this financial year for the construction of the office. The members were in agreement that payment of rent amounting to Ksh 840,000 per year was not viable in the long run and also wastage of public funds. The members therefore proposed to set aside ksh 5,000,000 for the construction of the office. The chairman also informed the members that there was public land situated in Section 9 and the other situated at the public works compound but shall together with the DCC discuss the location conclusively. He however noted that allocating the funds was the 1st step towards achieving the goal of having an office. The public works officer was consulted and she advised that a good office was estimated at ksh 12,000,000.

STRATEGIC PLAN

The members were also informed that they were required to set aside ksh 2,000,000 fo the development of the constituency's strategic plan for the period 2023-2027. The members were in agreement that it was important for the constituency to have a plan which will steer the NG-CDFC towards achieving its goal.

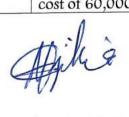

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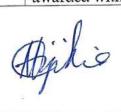
