**MIN: 5/16/09/2020: PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR 2020/2021 FY**

The Fund Account Manager informed members that the board have officially communicated through a circular dated 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020 calling for submission of Project Proposals for the 2020/2021 financial year. She further said that allocation for this financial



year amounts to **Kshs, 137,165,879.31 (one hundred thirty seven million, one hundred and sixty five thousand eight hundred and seventy nine cents thirty one only)**. She reminded members that the only eligible projects for funding must be within the Act; they must be community based and falls within the functions of the National Government as per the constitution.

Members therefore referred to the ward report regarding proposed projects at community level and also constituency strategic plan (2018-2022) and after lengthy deliberations, the NGCDFC Committee approved the list below as proposed projects for 2020/2021 financial year.


**MIN: 8/16/09/2020: STAFF LEAVE ALLOWANCES FOR THE YEAR 2020**
