**PREAMBLE**

**INTRODUCTION**

The meeting started at 2.18p.m with a word of prayer led by Rev. Henry Waroga. Mary Njeri Ting'ang'a Ward representative welcomed those present and thanked them for finding time to attend the meeting and requested them to present viable projects.

The FAM informed members of the public on the eligibility criteria as stipulated in section 22(1) of the act which states:

- ❖ The project under this act shall be community based in order to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a wide spread cross-section of inhabitants of a particular area.
- ❖ Further, projects supporting religious bodies, political bodies are not eligible for funding.”

This was followed by brief speeches as follows;

**The Assistant County Commissioner** urged members of the public to take initiative in matters of development and she requested the public to give a list of projects which they felt were priority to be considered for funding. He also spoke about the illicit brew and urged the youths to shun the habit and get involved in development activities. Security matter was also addressed; the youths were urged to not involve themselves in criminal activities.

**Hon Jude Njomo**, thanked members for attending the meeting. He also pointed out that the Ting'ang'a youth empowerment center which has been fully funded and completed by Kiambu NG-CDF will be handed over to a youth group who will manage and run the project. The area residents requested him to furnish the center with workstations and chairs and equip it with computers, printers and internet services. He also emphasized on the need to raise the education standards in our Constituency.
