The issue of 100% transition from primary to secondary school was also pointed out. This was followed closely by the introduction of Jane Njeri Njuguna - Assistant Chief – Ndumberi Sublocation.




The Kiambu NG-CDF Chairman gave his remarks. He then introduced the NG-CDF Committee to the residents of Ndumberi as per the picture below;



The Fund Account Manager was introduced to the public and gave her remarks as summarized below;

✓ She informed members of the public on the eligibility criteria as stipulated in section 24 of the NG-CDF Act that states that; eligible projects are only those that falls within the functions of the National Government under the Constitution, must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area. Further, she encouraged them to consider projects that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity and protection of the marginalized among other values and principles of governance as outlined in Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya.

After this, she welcomed Hon. John Machua to give his remarks which he did as follows;



He started by thanking all the people of Ndumberi Ward for electing him as their M.P. and wished them a happy new year 2023. He promised them that he will work closely with everyone in order to achieve the vision set for Kiambu Constituents irrespective of the constituency being cosmopolitan with different challenges. 


