The major issues were education, security and roads.

1. Education

1.1 School infrastructure

1.1.1 St. Kevin Secondary school

The school appreciates the NGCDF through Hon. Wamaeukuru for purchasing them a school bus. However, the NGCDF needs to consider funding the following projects in the school:

- An incomplete building the school
- Girls ablution block
- School face-lifting
- Gate
- Water harvesting and landscaping
- A good dormitory,



1.1.2 PCEA Kanjera Booth Girls Secondary School.

There was a well-wisher who has constructed a dormitory and a swimming pool for the school. The school appreciates the NGCDF for the school bus. It however needs a perimeter wall.

1.1.3 Kamonjoni secondary school MANAGER

The school needs more classrooms some of which should be designed in such a way that they can accommodate the disabled learners.

1.1.4 Kahuho-Uhuru High school.

The school appreciates NGCDF for the construction of two classrooms. The school however, is in need of;

- A 500 capacity dormitory.

1.1.5 Kanjeru primary school.

The school is in need of the following;

Some parents whose children study in far distant schools were finding it very hard to the bursary forms to these schools for stamping.




2. Security

Insecurity was cited as one of the major challenges affecting the residents of Muguga ward. This was caused majorly by the high number of unemployment youths in the ward. The urgent measures that the residents want taken to curb this were as follows

2.1 Street lights

The following areas need street lighting;

- Kanjeru road (near Kanjeru primary school)
- Kang'eng'u
- Gililu
- Shauri



2.2 Improvement of police station and police officer's welfare

The residents would love to see the following done:

- Completion of Muguga police post
- Construction of a perimeter wall at Kahuho police station
- Furnishing of the OCS office at Kahuho police station
- Construction of better houses for the police officers in Kahuho police station
- Deployment of more police officers at Kahuho police station.

2.3 Improvement of Chief's office

The residents from Kahuho location want the chief's office to have a latrine and better furniture.

3. Roads

Members of the community complained of poor drainage and poor status some roads and they would like to see these roads improved.

3.1 Drainage

The following are roads whose drainage system needs to be worked on;



- Kanjeru road
- Wangige- Ngechaa road

3.2 Maintenance and improvement

The residents want the following roads improved

- Wangige – Ngecha road: The road needs recarpeting
- Gatuanabu road; the road needs to be tarmacked
- Kwa Nyeli road: needs to be tarmacked
- Bob's- Migumoini road; improved to all weather road
- Kairba road; improved to all weather road
- Ha Gachini-Gatuangathi road; improved to all weather
- Gitau-Kahuho road; improved to all weather
- Ha Gachini-Maturuku road'; improved to all weather
- Part of the road leading to the cattle dip has been grabbed and needs to be repossessed back to the public.

4. Others

Other areas that the community would like the NGCDF and the office of the MP h help them were: community water, electricity and the youth & sports.

4.1 Community water

- The borehole in Gititu need to be connected to power for pumping water and supply to the community.
- Kang'engu area needs piped water.

4.2 Electricity connectivity

- A three phase transformer is needed at Kahuho
- Some transformers are faulty and need replacement.

4.3 Youths and sports

- Alcohol and drug abuse among the youth in the ward was identified as a very thorny issue and needs to be addressed urgently. The elected leaders, provincial administration and the security personnel need to work in harmony to reduce this.
- The public schools need to open the playing fields to the public so that the youths involved in ball games use them for exercises.
- The labor force needed for NGCDF works should come from the constituency youths.

4.4 Response from the MP.

The area member of parliament response to some of the above issues was:

- Construction of one big modern kitchen from where food to all schools will be distributed. Parents will be required to pay Ksh 15. For their children's lunch.
- All schools will have a perimeter wall
- All primary schools will have the junior secondary classrooms constructed by the NGCDF
- The county and extra county schools need to set aside one class for admitting the learners from the ward
- Bursary forms will only require stamps from the area chiefs and by the Pastor/priest.
- Labor and expertise needed in NGCDF projects will come from Kibete constituency.


The meeting started with a word of prayer by Vicar Allan Njogu Kimondo who read verse of the day from the book of Proverbs 16:3.






They also requested for a place of drug addicted victims to be rehabilitated also to look on the talented people and motivate them.




After the introduction Mheshimiwa the (M.P) thanked the residents for re-electing him and passed greetings from the president and his vice.




Kibichiku secondary school need a multipurpose hall as priority to be able to hold meetings, needs a shade for their bus and a landscaping of the school ground and solar panel





- ✓ Youth & sport










The community members requested for:


There is also an outcry of grabbing public land like the market area which is already grabbed. Maendeleo ya wanawake plot was also grabbed showing the need solving the problem.

MIN: 03/01/2023: PROJECTS PROPOSAL BUDGET FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2022/2023

The Chairman briefed members that the committee is required to submit project proposals for the financial year 2022/2023 in time to get funds, the Fund Account Manager told members that the NG-CDF Committee is supposed to submit projects proposals to the NC-CDF Board as per the guidelines of the National Government projects.

The Fund Account Manager informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of **Kshs.145,037,603.00**.The Fund Account Manager briefed members on the guidelines for project proposal presentation and also informed members on the eligible projects. The manager informed members that all devolved functions are no longer eligible under the new NG-CDF act.

The committee members agreed to prioritize on ongoing projects i.e Kamuguga Police Station, Wangige secondary school, NG-CDF office and Kabete High school as per the implementation status.



Further committee members agreed on the following

- **Kamuguga Police Station:** After a lengthy deliberation, members agreed to allocate kshs. 8,000,000.00 which will be adequate to complete the project
- **Kabete Secondary School:** It was reported that the school has managed to raise some funds to assist in completion of the project as they had earlier promised. The committee agreed to allocate kshs. 2,000,000.00
- **NG-CDF office:** The committee discussed and resolved to construct 2 more floors instead of concentrating on finishing of the current structure in place which is ground, 1st, 2nd and 3rd floor




